Allocation Purpose:

The grant will fund twelve months of salary, fringe benefits, fifty hours of overtime, travel/training, and supply costs for one Infrastructure Protection (IP) Analyst and one Homeland Security (HS) Intelligence Analyst. The analysts will work in the Southeast Wisconsin Threat Analysis Center (STAC). The STAC, co-located with MPD's Intelligence Fusion Center, is an information-sharing center for the eight counties in southeastern Wisconsin including Milwaukee, Waukesha, Racine, Kenosha, Walworth, Ozaukee, Washington, and Dodge. The analysts will coordinate and develop intelligence products to share with public and private sector and law enforcement partners.

Program Goals:

The STAC provides a platform for collaboration among multiple federal, state, local, and tribal agencies and disciplines to exchange information and intelligence, with the goal to improve the ability to detect, prevent, deter, and respond to crime and terrorism by analyzing data from various sources. The IP and HS Intelligence Analysts will coordinate risk, threat, and vulnerability assessments and share information with partners.

Programmatic Summary:

The funding will fully cover twelve months of salary and fringe benefits for the Infrastructure Protection (IP) Analyst and the Homeland Security (HS) Intelligence Analyst, as well as fifty hours of overtime for each position, travel, training, and supply costs.
