The claimant, Ms. Marilyn Jackson, is a City of Milwaukee Sanitation Department worker. She was in the scope of her employment and operating a City of Milwaukee vehicle that was stopped on West Hampton Avenue at the red light waiting to make a right turn onto West Fond du Lac Avenue when the uninsured motorist, who was traveling westbound on Hampton Avenue, rearended the City vehicle.

The uninsured motorist then fled the scene of the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to § 62.67, Wis. Stats., and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Ms. Jackson sustained injuries to her neck, back and chest area. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$4,393.90.
