Dear Mr. Yousuf:

This is to notify you that on October 18, 2011, the City's Public Safety Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your renewal application for a public passenger vehicle driver license be renewed with a 60 day suspension based upon the police report and your driving record.

On October 19, 2011, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendations of the Public Safety Committee with respect to your renewal application for a public passenger vehicle driver license. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of November 2, 2011, commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. You did not appear nor did you file written objections. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Public Safety Committee, the Common Council adopted the recommendation of the Public Safety Committee to renew your public passenger driver license with a 60 day suspension based upon the police report and your driving record.

Said suspension is to be in effect from the date of Common Council hearing of November 2, 2011 and for 60 days thereafter, through midnight, December 31, 2011.
