Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations): The 2014 Urban Forestry grant will conduct an historical comparison of Milwaukee's tree canopy pre- and post-Dutch elm disease to quantify the changes in ecosystem benefits including air quality, energy savings and stormwater retention. It shifts the focus of urban forestry management in the face of Emerald Ash Borel and other invasive pests and disease beyond tree removal and replacement costs to the value of urban forest green infrastructure and the value of ecosystem benefits provided over time.			
2.	Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives: It is the mission of DPW Operations - Forestry to protect and maintain the city's urban forest and 120-mile boulevard system. The return on investment generated by these green assets goes beyond aesthetics. The urban tree canopy provides \$15 million in stormwater benefits, \$900,000 in cooling benefit and reduces harmful emissions from 350,000 cars annually. Assessing Milwaukee's Urban Tree Canopy Cover, Composition & Benefits aims to quantify the economic & ecological impact from the loss of tree canopy as a result of Dutch elm disease
