PETITION FOR VACATING.

To the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee:

The petition of the undersigned owners of property in the 12th Ald. Dist. of the City of Milwaukee respectfully represents:

That your petitioners are the owners of all the property in the 12th Ald. Dist. of said city which abuts upon the portion West Canal Street from the South Menomonee Canal to a point 250 feet, more or less, west

which is proposed to be vacated, each owning the property immediately following his signature to this petition hereinafter subscribed.

That the petitioners are of the opinion that the public interest requires a vacation of West Canal Street from the South Menomonee Canal to a point 250 feet, more or less, west as shown on the map and descriptions hereto attached

and they are further of the opinion that the aforesaid portion of street is no longer of any public utility.

That the land proposed to be vacated and the location and situation of the proposed portion of street to be vacated as aforesaid are more particularly shown in the annexed map, the same being shaded on said map to distinguish it from property surrounding and adjacent thereto, which said map is hereto annexed and made a part of this petition.

That, as provided by Section 80.32 Wisconsin Statutes, such vacation shall not terminate the easements acquired and the rights of the public in any of the underground structures, improvements, or services, as enumerated or otherwise existing in said portion of street and in said description of land hereto annexed but such easements and right and all rights of entrance, maintenance, construction, and repair with reference thereto shall continue as if such portion of street had not been vacated.

That all petitioners hereby waive notice of the public hearing on this petition, and all petitioners who will take possession of property to which the benefit of public improvements will accrue as a result of this vacation, do hereby waive their right to notice and hearing and agree to the special assessments for such benefits.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray that the piece and parcel of land described as aforesaid may be vacated according to law for the reason that the same is no longer of public utility, and that it will be for the public interest to have the same vacated.
