THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE PROPOSES TO FIND INNOVATIVE WAYS TO UNLOCK THE POTENTIAL FOR CREATING JOBS FOR RESIDENTS WHO LIVE NEAR THE MENOMONEE VALLEY. PROJECT INCLUDES CONDUCTING ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES THAT WILL FORM THE BASIS OF AN AQUA-SHED APPROACH FOR REMEDIATION AND REDEVELOPMENT. TARGET POPULATION IS ABOUT 68,000 PEOPLE.
