A fence located in a side yard (between houses) may not exceed a height of 4', unless all portions of the fence higher than 4' are at least 50% open construction (e.g. lattice). Solid fences placed near the intersection of two streets, a driveway with a street, or an alley with a street, shall be no more than 3' high. This applies within 10' of a driveway intersection, and within 15 to 25' of other intersections depending on the zoning district. The fence must be built entirely on your property and shall not extend over lot lines. Fences shall not be located within the street or alley (public) right-of-way unless the project meets all the applicable requirements of Ch 245 Milwaukee Code of Ordinances. All fences shall be constructed in a workman-like manner and of approved fencing material. Plywood sheets, snow fence, chicken wire & plastic material less than ½" thick are prohibited. All structural elements of the fence must face inwards (toward your property). Supports shall not face toward the street or neighboring property. 							
Case # Approved Historic Preservation Comm COA dated	 Solid fences 4' or more in height shall be properly anchored to a minimum depth of 30 inches. All fences shall be uniform in color. Two colors are allowed if the fence is painted, stained or otherwise properly finished. If the new fence is constructed parallel to and within 6' of an existing fence on the same lot, the existing fence shall be removed within 10 days of completion of the new fence.
