

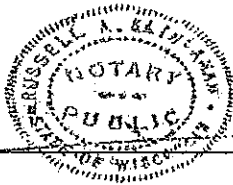



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to law, the City Plan Commission will hold a public hearing on Monday, April 6, 2020, at 1:30 p.m. in the 1st Floor Boardroom, 809 N. Broadway, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, at which time persons interested in the creation of the following Neighborhood Improvement District, will be given an opportunity to be heard:

Establishment of the boundary of Neighborhood Improvement District No. 11 (River Ridge) and approval of its Initial Operating Plan for the area generally bounded by properties that front West River Ridge Drive, all properties that front North 103rd Street, all properties that front West Wabash Avenue, all properties that front West Dean Road, all properties that front North 102nd Court and all properties that front North 100th Street. This configuration accounts for 43 individual lots that make up the River Ridge Home Owners Association, in the 9th Aldermanic District.
