At a public hearing held on December 11, 2006, the Historic Preservation Commission voted to individually designate on an interim basis, the properties addressed at 2005 and 2009 E. Kenwood Boulevard in accordance with the provisions of Section 308-81-10.5 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, with finding, based on the record, a likelihood of success of permanent designation based on criteria e-5 and e-8 of the Historic Preservation Ordinance.

Also, according to Section 308-81-10.5(g), a public hearing shall be held within 90 days of the date of the initiation of the interim designation to consider final designation of the buildings. You will be notified as to the date, place and time of this meeting. Section 308-81-10.5 (f) provides that the owner may appeal the Commission's decision to the Common Council by filing a signed and acknowledged petition with the City Clerk within five days of the date of the Commission's decision asking for a review of the Commission's decision.
