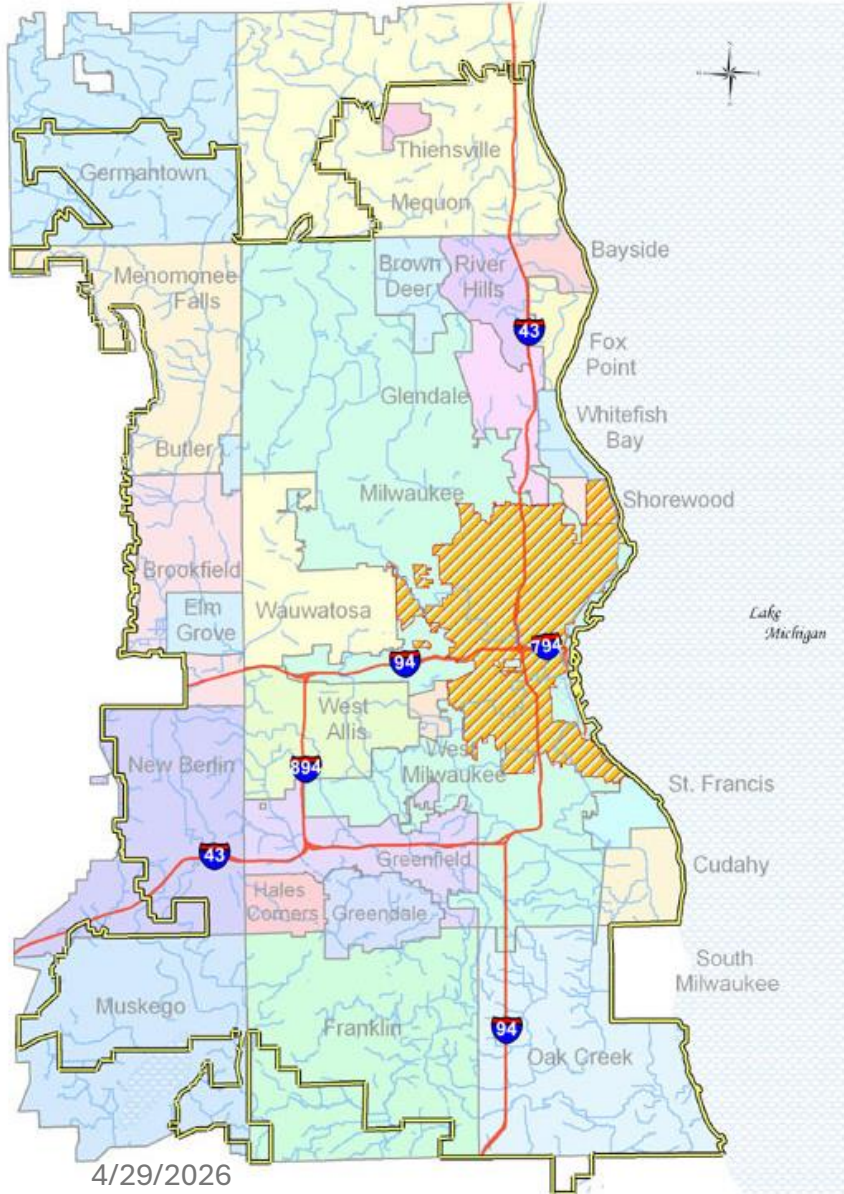

- 423 Square Miles

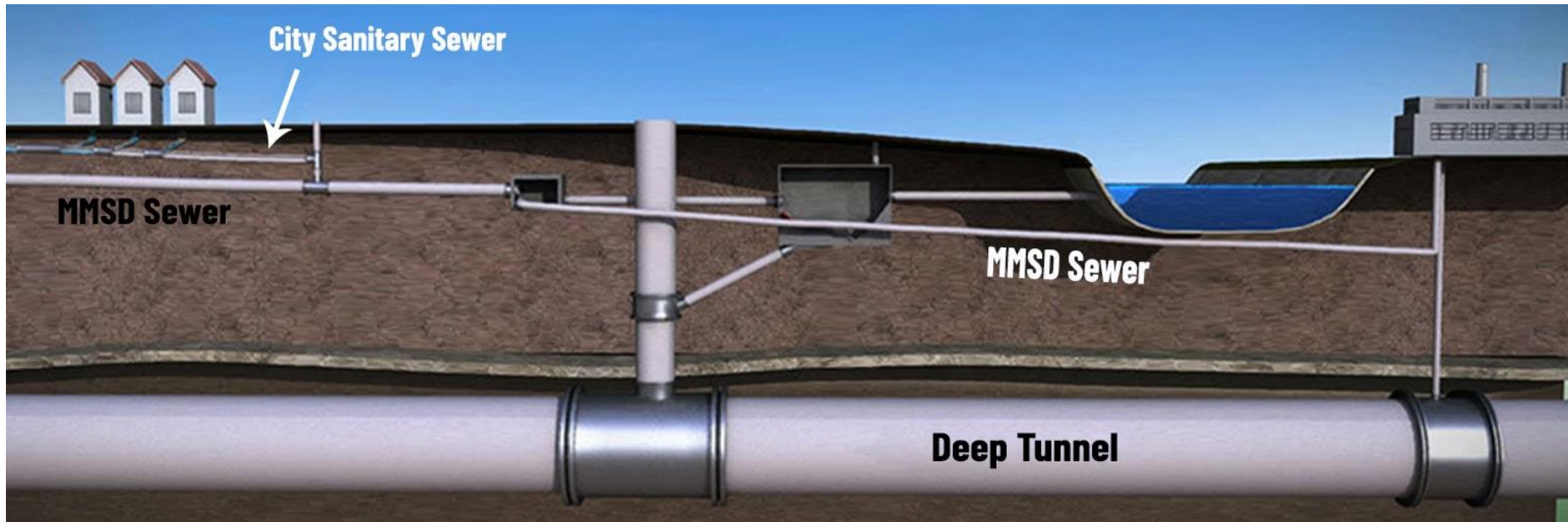
## We Protect the Public & Lake Michigan

- 521 MG Tunnel System

Watch the video to learn what happens when MMSD opens and closes the Deep Tunnel "gates" to reduce the risk of basement backups.



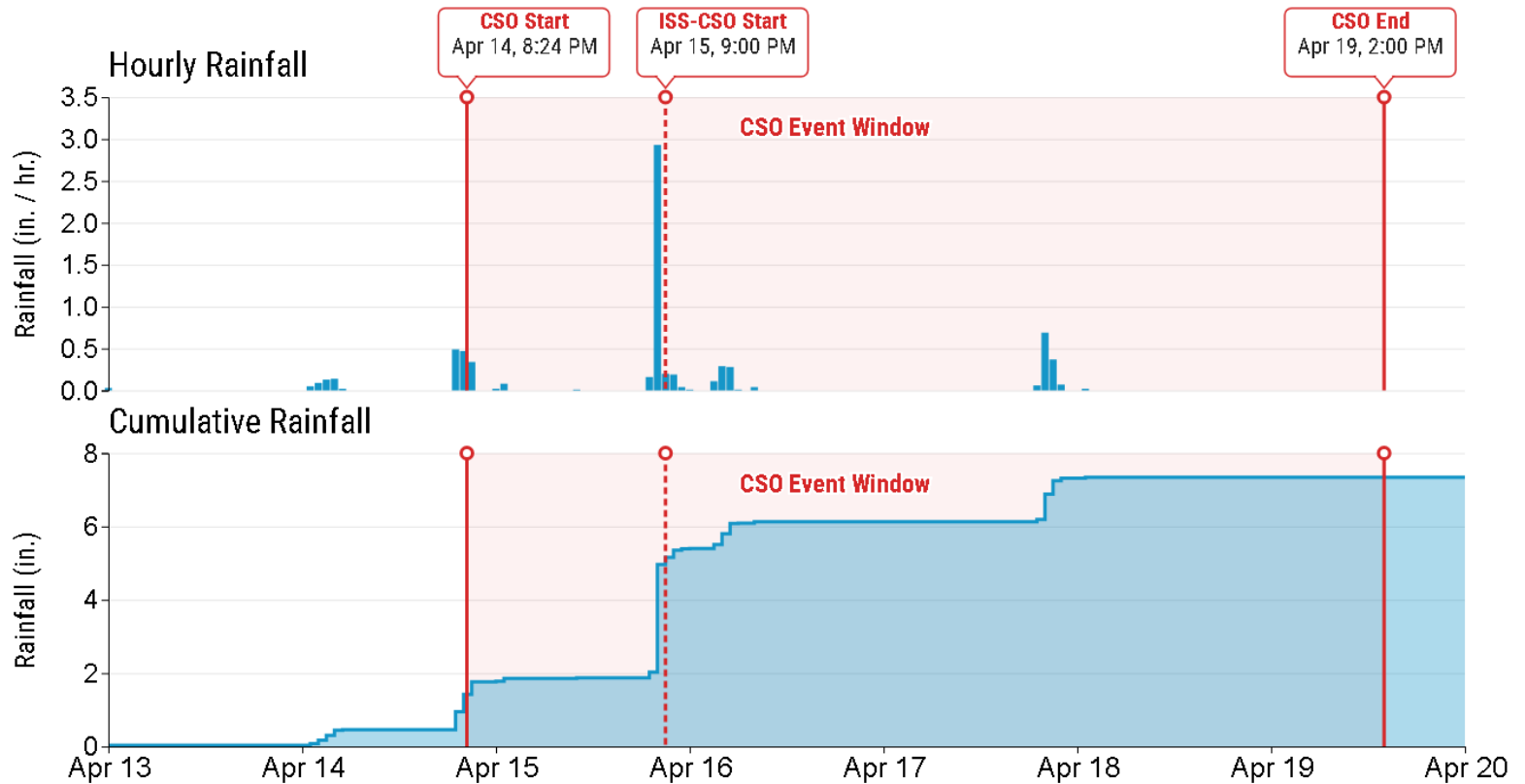
# April 2 – April 4, 2026 event

- Rainfall over 3 inches in downtown area between 4/2 and 4/4
- Deep Tunnel volume peaked at 353 MG (432 MG total volume available)
- Combined Sewer Overflow volume – 0 MG
- Separate Sewer Overflow volume – 0 MG

# April 14 – April 20, 2026 event

- Prolonged rainfall with 4 inches in April prior to 4/14 and over 7 inches in downtown area between 4/14 and 4/18
- Deep Tunnel volume peaked at 398 MG (432 MG total volume available)
- Combined Sewer Overflow volume – 2.7 BG
- Separate Sewer Overflow volume – 12 MG

## Jones Island Weather Station: April 13 - 19

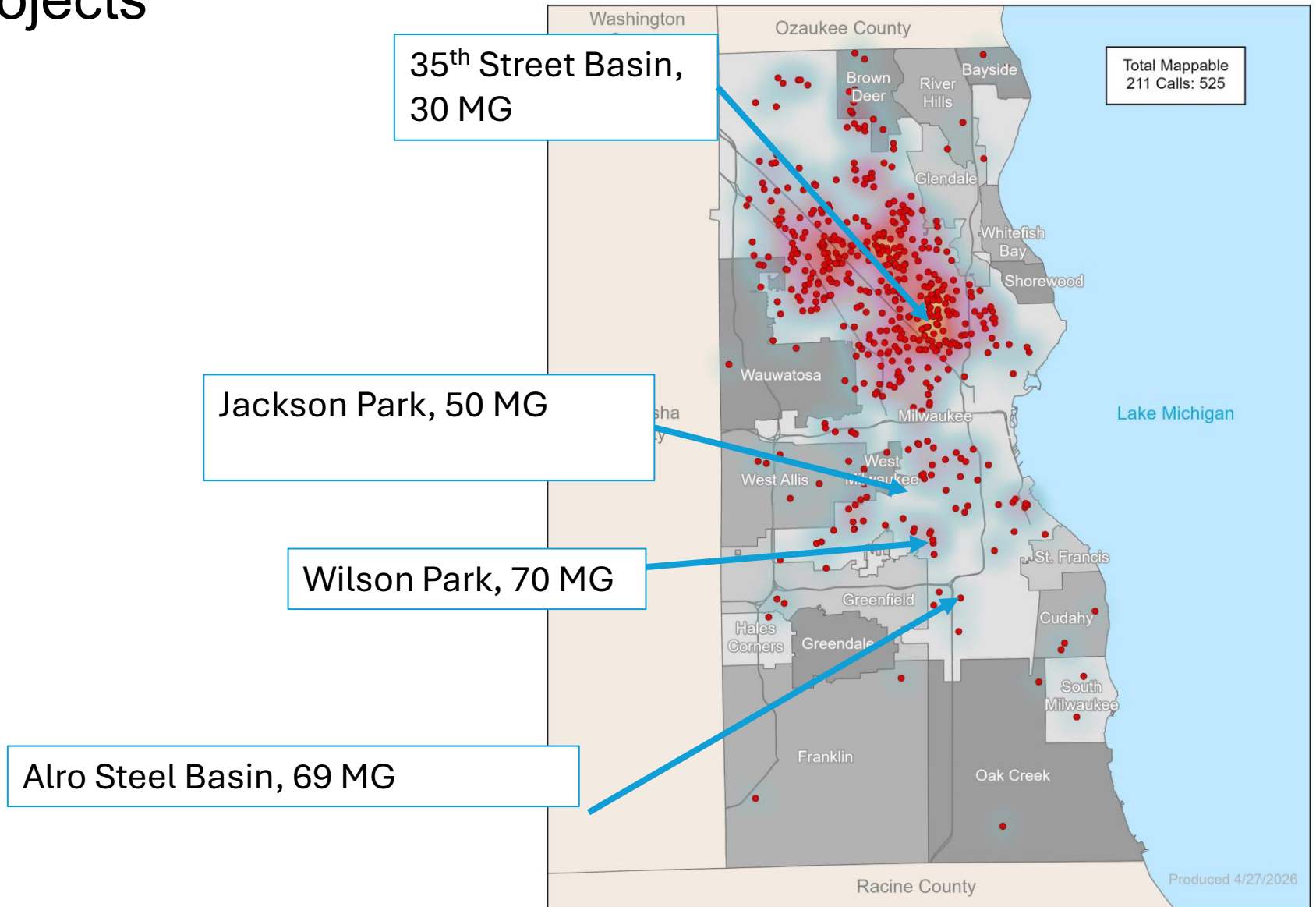
