If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Yellow cab #133 was observed pulling away from a taxi stand at the Intercontinental Hotel with a client in the back. After the client was dropped off at 1665 N Van Buren St the driver was approached and asked to roll up the rear window to locate the red out of service sticker. The sticker was completely covered up by a credit card advertisement. The driver was asked why he was driving this vehicle and he said the owner wants his weekly rent money for leasing the cab. The applicant is the owner of this vehicle and he admitted to knowing the car had brake problems but knows nothing about the covered up sticker. The applicant was cited for:

THE ABOVE NAMED COMPLAINING WITNESS BEING DULY SWORN, ON INFORMATION AND BELIEF STATES THAT:

Count 1: DISORDERLY CONDUCT

The above-named defendant on or about Thursday, May 24, 2012, in the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, while in a public place, did engage in otherwise disorderly conduct, under circumstances in which such conduct tended to cause a disturbance, contrary to sec. 947.01(1), 939.51(3)(b) Wis. Stats.

Upon conviction for this offense, a Class B Misdemeanor, the defendant may be fined not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), or imprisoned not more than ninety (90) days, or both.

Count 2: FALSE IMPRISONMENT

The above-named defendant on or about Thursday, May 24, 2012, in the area of the 8000-8200 blocks of W Grant Street, in the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, did intentionally confine KMB, without that person's consent, and with knowledge that he had no lawful authority to do so, contrary to sec. 940.30, 939.50(3)(h) Wis. Stats.

Upon conviction for this offense, a Class H Felony, the defendant may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Count 3: FOURTH DEGREE SEXUAL ASSAULT

The above-named defendant on or about Thursday, May 24, 2012, in the area of the 8000-8200 blocks of W Grant Street, in the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, did have sexual contact with KMB, without consent, contrary to sec. 940.225(3m), 939.51(3)(a) Wis. Stats.

Upon conviction for this offense, a Class A Misdemeanor, the defendant may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than nine (9) months, or both.

Complainant is a West Allis Police Detective and bases this complaint upon information and belief.

Upon the statement of Jayna R, a juvenile female (d.o.b. 3/2/1999). Jayna R. states that on the morning of May 24, 2012, at about 7:10 a.m., she was walking to school (Lincoln Intermediate School) and she was walking through a Pick N Save parking lot and was walking toward Orchard St. As she approached Orchard St, she saw a yellow cab parked on that street. As she walked past the cab the driver asked her several times if she wanted a ride. She continued to walk toward school and the driver of the cab was driving along side of her, continually asking her if she needed a ride and telling her that he had cigarettes for her. She states that the cab continued to follow her for several blocks and she was scared because the driver would not leave her alone. She finally turned on Lapham and the cab did not follow her.

Upon the statement of Katelynn B, a juvenile female (d.o.b. 1/26/1996). Katelynn B. states that on the morning of May 24, 2012, she arrived at West Allis Central High School and then decided to leave to meet a friend. This was at about 7:20 a.m. She left the school and was walking eastbound on Becher and she was between 79th and 80th Streets when she saw a yellow cab parked on Becher. As she walked past the cab, the driver asked her if she wanted a ride. She told the driver that she was only going two blocks, but he told her that it was not a problem. She then got into the cab and the driver drove her to the intersection of 78th and Lincoln. She got out of the cab and met her friend. She and her friend talked for about 10-15 minutes and then her friend got on a bus and she started to walk back to school. As she was walking on Becher, she saw the yellow cab parked in the 7700 block of Becher. As she walked past the cab, the driver, the same man who drove her to 78th and Lincoln, told her that he could give her a ride to school and she got into the cab, in the front seat. He then started driving her toward the school. When he was in the 8000 block of W. Grant St, he stopped the cab and then he locked the doors of the cab. The driver then grabbed her hand and told her that he liked her. He then put his hand on her thigh and he attempted to pull up her dress, but she pushed his hand away. The driver then grabbed her breast and squeezed it several times and he kissed her on the cheek and told her that he liked her boob. She was asking him what he was doing and telling him that she needed to go to school. The man suddenly stopped and drove her to school. She stated that she did not give him consent to lock her in or to touch her breast.

Complainant states that subsequent investigation led to the identification of Opinder Singh as being the cab driver involved in these two incidents. On May 31, 2012, Singh was arrested and then interviewed about these incidents. Singh stated that a girl had approached his cab and asked him for a cigarette. He offered the girl a ride and drove her to the area of 76th and Becher and dropped her off. When he dropped her off he told her that he would give her a ride back to school if he did not have another customer. A few minutes later he saw the same girl and she was walking westbound on Becher. She got into his cab, in the front seat. He stated that he drove but pulled over and parked near 82nd and Grant. He stated that while parked, he touched the girl's hand and her breast. When asked if she gave him permission, he said No. He also admitted that the girl appeared to be uncomfortable. He stated that he then drove her back to school. Singh denied locking the doors of the cab.

Singh was also asked if, on May 24, 2012, in the morning, he came into contact with a young girl in the area of 69th and Orchard. He stated that he did. He stated that he had followed a young girl and had asked her if she needed a ride. He also said that he asked her if she smoked. Singh stated that he thought the girl was about 13 or 14 years old. He said that he did ask her several times if she wanted a ride, but the girl kept walking and never got into his cab.

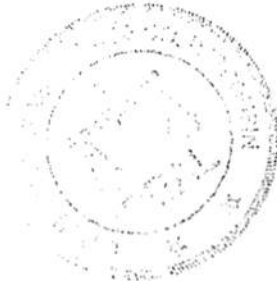
