The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

Any new sidewall vent pipes for heating equipment, must onj the rear elvation or as far back onthe side elevations as possible where they are not visible form the street. All plastic pipes must be painted out the blend with the colors of the surrounding building materials.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
