Dear Alderman Perez,

I hope this email finds you well. I am writing to urgently address a concerning issue regarding the operation of food trucks on 13th Street between Mitchel Street and Lapham Boulevard, and I kindly request your immediate attention and assistance in resolving this matter.

The presence of food trucks in our neighborhood has unfortunately led to a series of disturbances and safety hazards that cannot be ignored. Not only are these food trucks attracting unruly individuals who engage in late-night loitering, but they are also contributing to increased littering and reckless driving in the area. Furthermore, the noise pollution caused by their generators, combined with the loud music, voices, and occasional arguments from their customers, persists well into the early morning hours, disrupting the peace and tranquility of our residential community.

In addition to these ongoing concerns, I must bring to your attention a recent and deeply troubling incident that occurred this past Saturday, May 10, 2024. Tacos Guelaguetza, one of the food trucks operating on 13th Street, was reportedly robbed on this date. Shockingly, the incident was not

reported to the police, raising serious questions about the safety and security measures in place at these establishments.

Furthermore, the frequency of such incidents, coupled with the history of violence in the vicinity of these food trucks, is deeply concerning and poses a significant risk to the safety and well-being of our community.

While I understand and support the importance of fostering a vibrant local economy, it is imperative that the operations of these food trucks do not compromise the safety and well-being of our residents. Therefore, I urge you to take immediate and decisive action to address these issues, including exploring alternative locations for the food trucks where they can conduct their business without posing a threat to public safety and residential peace.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. I eagerly await your response and action in addressing these urgent concerns and ensuring the safety and tranquility of our neighborhood.



The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 3/6/2025 at 9:25 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.





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
