However, the petitioner also owns property at 3570 North Teutonia Avenue where we are having enforcement problems relating to the maintenance of the property, illegal outdoor storage, and illegal repair/storage of vehicles. There is also a pending charge of \$120 for reinspection fees.

The Department recommends that the return of this property be contingent upon the owner paying the fees due on 3570 North Teutonia and providing the Department with a written commitment to comply with the code enforcement and zoning orders.
