If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Good Afternoon –

MHD just completed a spot check at the location and trucks Parrilla Mixe and El Carboncito were onsite. We confirmed that both of these trucks already received their 2026 routine therefore we did not need to complete any inspections today. The inspector shared that the parking lot was not a concern for trash and only 1 car was parked in the lot at the time.

El Rincon, however, has open orders from their routine 2026 inspection that we are attempting to follow-up on but have not had luck finding them in the field/no contact. They are also in need of a mobile renewal before they can get their truck license released (MHD hold) and are currently operating with a provisional that is good until Aug. We will continue to keep an eye out and await for them to reach out for this necessary inspection.

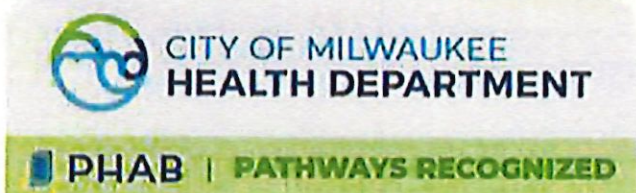

Good morning everyone,

P.O. Mendez and I responded yesterday to the BK and spoke with the GM, Juan Hernandez, who told us about the issues he's having with food truck patrons parking and using their private parking lot to eat and wait for their food, also leaving their garbage in the lot. We advised Juan to reach out to a tow company to contract with, and explained to him that the company will post signage regarding "unauthorized vehicles will be towed...", and that we will pass that message along to the food trucks along Forest Home Av. One of the BK managers we spoke with stated that the most uncooperative and confrontational food truck out of the 3 there is "El Rincon Fritanguero", the blue truck out there, which wasn't out there when we stopped by yesterday. We then spoke with the owners of El Carboncito and Parilla Mixe and advised them about the complaints from BK and that BK would be contracting with a tow company soon to tow unauthorized vehicles off their property. We would like to still advise El Rincon Fritanguero about the complaints, when we see them out there. I'll be doing License Premise reports for all food trucks regarding.

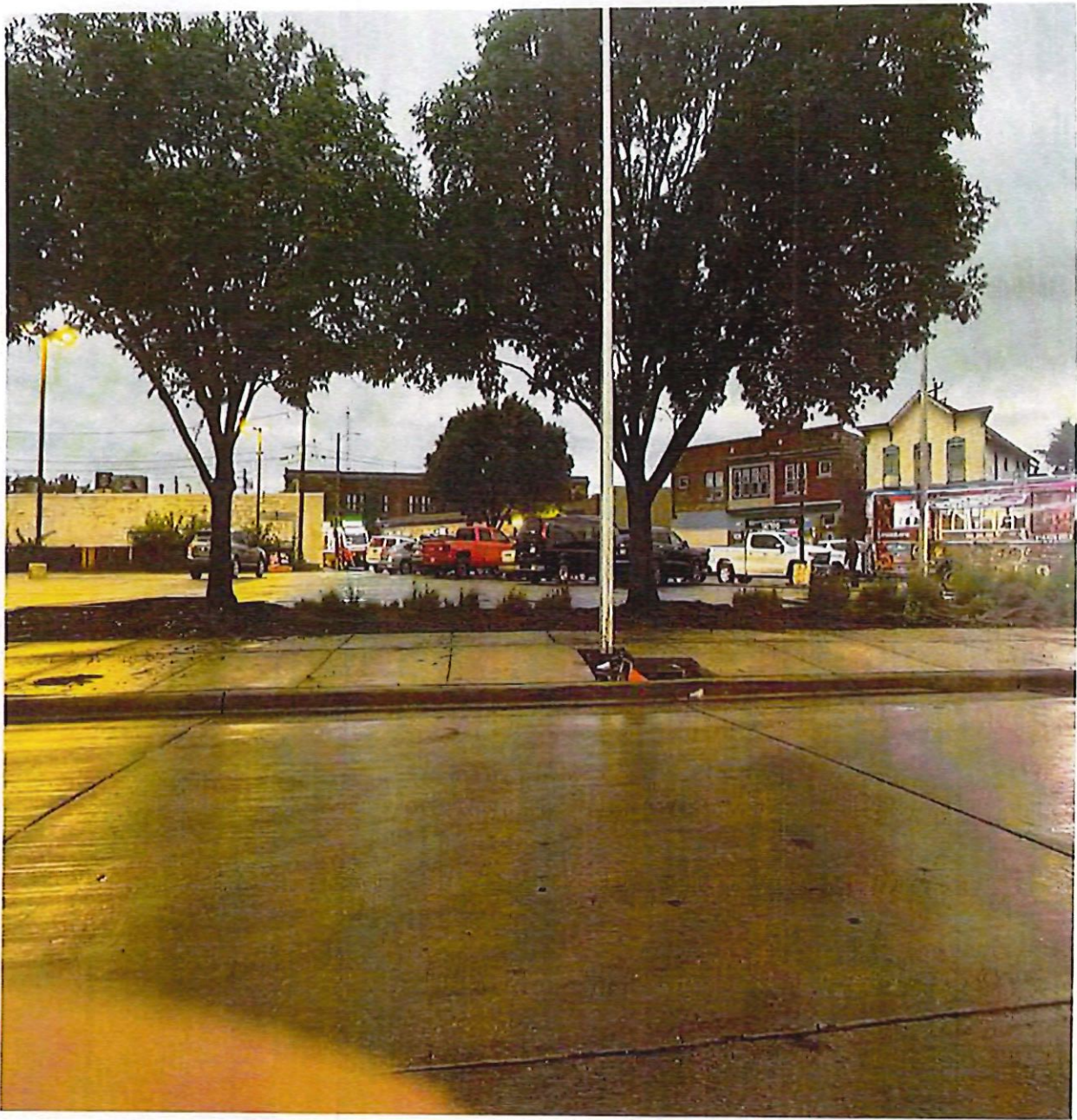

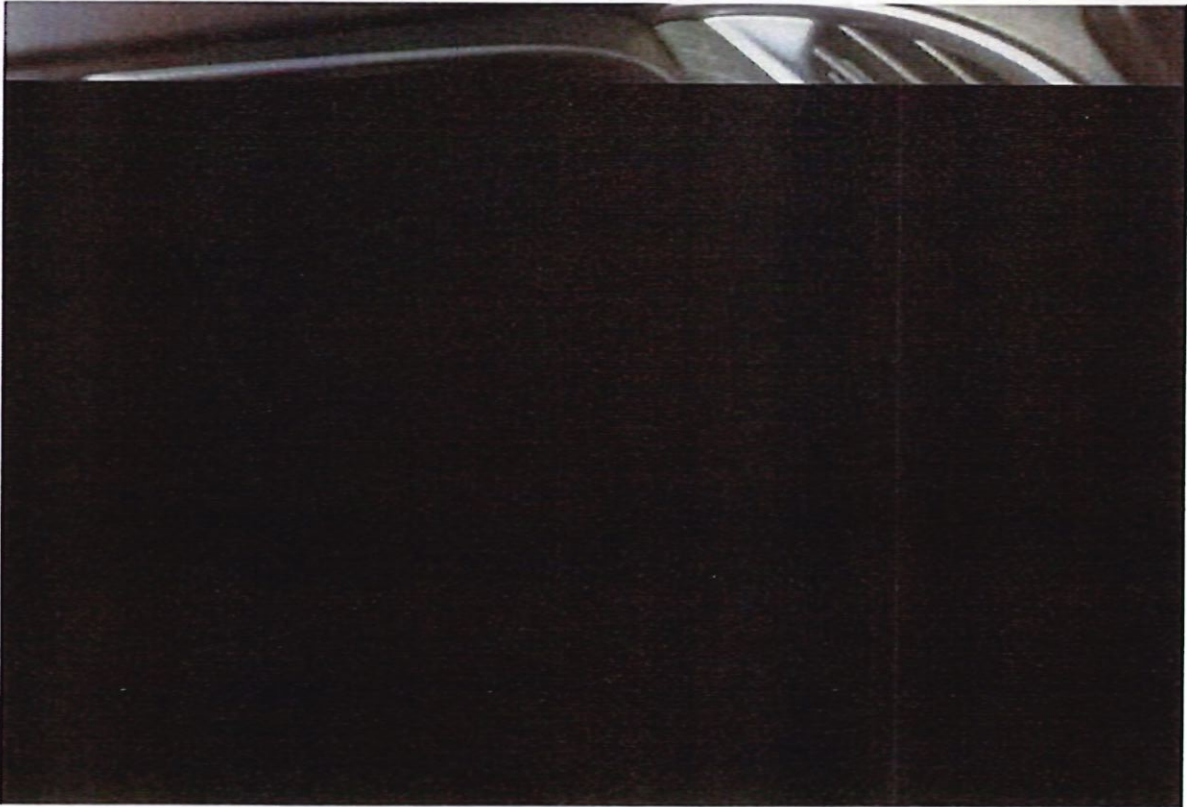

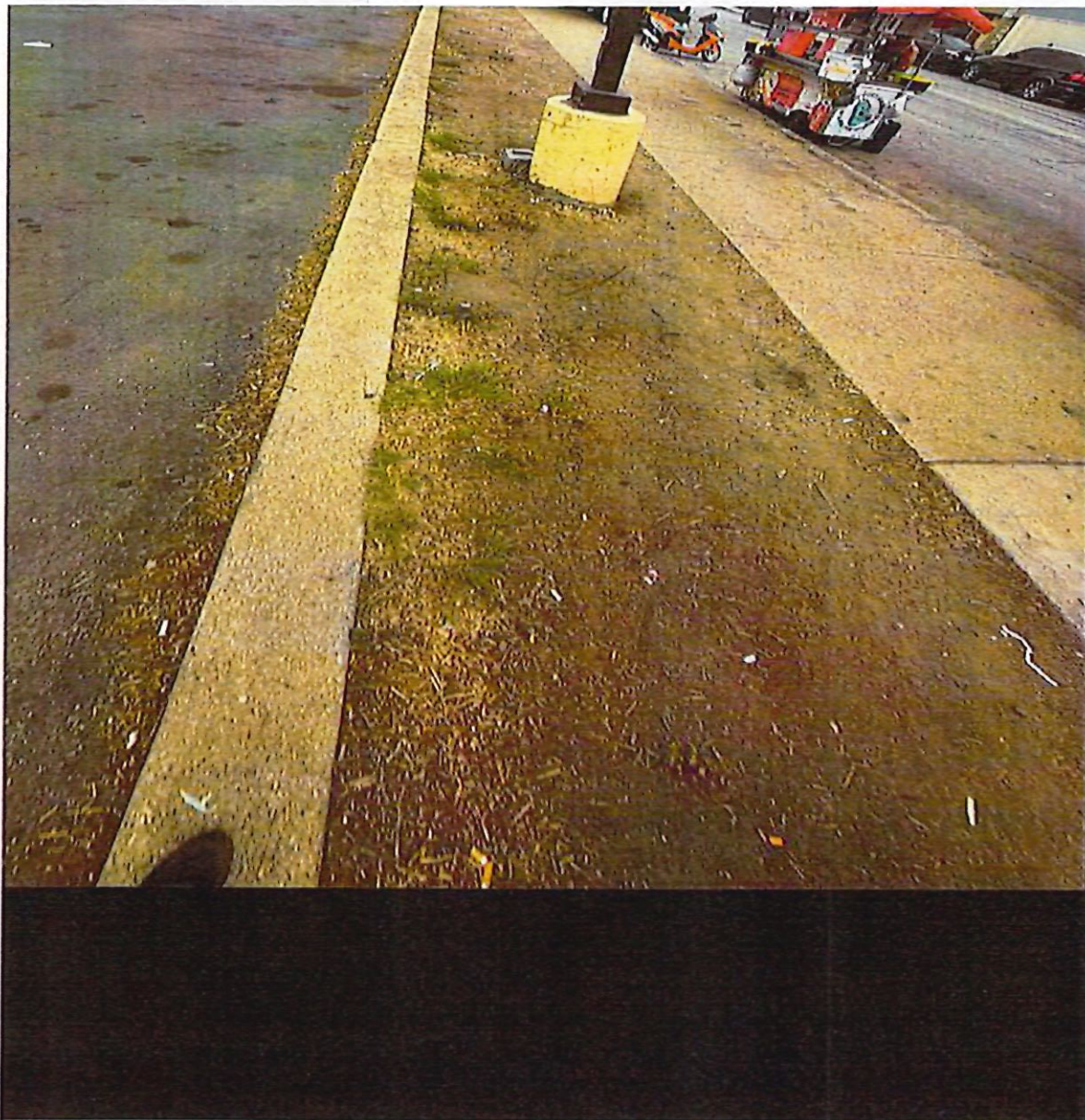

Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The Licenses application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the Licenses application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above Licenses application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the Licenses may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the Licenses application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a Licenses.

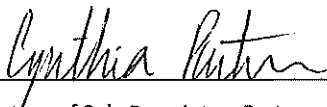
