WHEREAS, *On January 14, 2015, Med 13 arrived on the scene of a fire at 7730 W. Villard Ave.; and*

WHEREAS, *Med 13 demonstrated teamwork and bravery when responding to the medical needs of the fire victims, and performed the medical transport of a boy after he was found unconscious and not breathing; and*

WHEREAS, *Med 13 has served the Milwaukee Fire Department with honor and dedication and has always executed their duties with the greatest of skill and pride; and*

WHEREAS, *While special lieutenant Peter J. Anderson and fire paramedic Dennis D. Lewis Jr. are recognized for their bravery on the job, their actions and concern for the well-being of co-workers and of the citizens they work to protect are representative of all of the men and women of the Milwaukee Fire Department, who engage in thousands of hours of specialized training and continuing education, and who are committed to providing whatever assistance the citizens of Milwaukee need; now, therefore, be it*
