III. <u>DEPLOYMENT CRITERIA</u>

- B. Camera trailers may be requested by any work location provided the request is made by a member with the rank of lieutenant of police or higher. Requests for camera trailers by outside area law enforcement agencies must be approved by an inspector of police or higher authority.
 - The camera trailer can be used for any event, incident or venue where the use of surveillance cameras is deemed necessary. The primary function of a camera trailer is for use in large crowd settings or events, or where the need for off-site area surveillance is necessary.

IV. CAMERA CONSIDERATIONS, OPERATION, AND RESPONSIBILITY

F. The Fusion Division will be responsible for all mechanical maintenance of and repairs to the trailers. The Information Technology Division is responsible for all software and technology repairs and maintenance of trailers, cameras, and associated equipment. If a trailer is damaged or becomes inoperable, the Fusion Division shall be notified immediately via email at REDACTED
