We are appealing Citation PWCF-22-00313 (exhibit C).

All-Ways Contractors went to DPW website under frequently asked questions & looked at question: What is fee/fine for not clearing sidewalk (City Ordinance 116-8) Exhibit A.

This clearly states we should have received a \$50 charge with an additional \$75 charge for a total of \$125.

We contacted Jason from Public Works Forestry, he said we were billed by the linear foot. He agreed with us that the language used on the DPW website is not how we were charged. He told us we should appeal this fine.

Also in our defense, Exhibit B shows a time in 10:57AM /time out 11:23AM for a total of 26 minutes of work by the DPW. The \$125 fine would be more in line for the work that was performed, not the \$746.30that was billed to us. Jason with the DPW Forestry agreed with me on this also.

Please reduce our fine to what the DPW Website states which is \$125



- Who do I contact if my neighbor did not clear their sidewalk?



What is the fee/fine for not clearing my sidewalk?

Properties in violation are assessed a special charge of \$50. Properties in violation will be posted, when possible, and referred to an abatement contractor on the same day. If the snow has not been removed from the sidewalk before the contractor arrives, the property owner will be charged for this cost and an additional service charge of \$75. This additional special charge increases to \$100 for subsequent violations within the same calendar year. (City Ordinance 116-8)

- There was a car parked on my street when the plow came through. Will DPW come back to clear the snow to the curb?
- Why did I see a truck driving in snow with its blade up?

All residents should clear snow and ice around, on top of, and to their garbage and recycling carts to create a clear path and serviceable condition for DPW crews.

Garbage and/or recycling collection may be delayed when staff are deployed to snow and ice control operations.

Sidewalks must be clear of snow and ice 24 hours after snow had stopped falling. Residents SHOULD NOT shovel, blow or plow snow back into the streets.

Sidewalk snow enforcement requests can be made online or by calling 414-286-CITY, however please do not make requests until the snow has stopped for 24 hours.

Updated: March 1, 2022

Ways you can help during a snow operation:

Park legally and follow alternate side parking rules. We do a better job clearing to the curb when parking rules are followed. Parking farther away from driveways, alleys and intersections allows our equipment to get closer to the curbs.

Sign up for Parking text alerts.

DO NOT shovel, blow or plow snow back into the streets.

Shovel your sidewalk within 24 hours after the snow has stopped falling, assist neighbors who are elderly or disabled.

Clear your hydrant of snow and ice.

Clear snow and ice around and on top of your garbage and recycling carts.

Adjust your driving for conditions by slowing down and providing more space for braking.

Give our trucks space and stay back from the trucks salting or brining streets to ensure the product hits the streets instead of your car.


Plan your route to stay on main transportation routes as much as possible during snow and ice events.

If you fail to pay the full amount of your property tax bill, including the special assessments and charges, your property will be eligible for in rem tax foreclosure action by the City of Milwaukee under Section 75.521, Wisconsin State Statutes, or you may be subject to a personal civil action by the City of Milwaukee under Section 74.53, Wisconsin State Statutes.

Return the appeal application along with the \$25 appeal filing fee to the Administrative Review Appeals Board, 200 E Wells St, Rm 205, within 120 days of the date of this letter.
