This report is written by Police Officer Xavier Benitez, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 07/01/20 while on patrol at 1800 W. Greenfield Av officers, observed a known prostitute sitting behind the gas station located at 1801 W. Greenfield Av. After the contact the officers observed overgrown landscape, large articles of trash, an abandoned trailer and the area littered with used needles. The un kept landscaping, and other items were aiding in the use of illegal drug activity and prostitution. Officers took pictures of the things observed and were assisted by a DNS Inspector. The inspector ordered a cleanup order of the area. The agent was not on scene and officers then set up a meeting with the agent regarding the issues in the back of the location.
- 2. On 12/09/20 at 10:48am, Milwaukee Police accompanied by Wisconsin Department of Revenue, Agent King conducted a license premise check at 1801 W. Greenfield Av. Officers observed two video gambling machines on the premise. The agent did not have the proper license for the machines and were cited regarding. Agent King seized 7 boxes of Tabaco products that were purchased by an unauthorized distributer.
- 3. On 12/14/20 at 2:41am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1801 W. Greenfield Av for a trouble with subject complaint. Officers spoke with the clerk who stated that a known subject took a food item out of the store, without paying. The subject then returned back the item to the store. The subject then left the area without further incident.

This report is written by PO Matthew DIENER, assigned to District 2, day shift, squad 2166. On Wednesday, July 1st, 2020, at approximately 12:00pm, squad 2166 (DIENER, VODICKA) was on patrol in the 1800 block of W Greenfield Av, when we observed a known prostitute, Holly M SLAGLE (w/f, 12-2-

70), sitting behind the gas station in between two overgrown bushes/weeds, adjusting her pants. SLAGLE stated that she "was sorry, but she had to use the bathroom really bad". I noticed the area where SLAGLE was littered with trash and garbage, and the landscaping was not maintained, creating a hiding spot. I also noticed needle litter, and orange needle caps laying about. I walked around the property and observed garbage was strewn over the entire property, and an abandoned storage trailer was behind the property, which also created a gangway where I could observe needle litter, cushions used for sleeping, and other articles of garbage in between the gas station wall and the storage container. The licensee was not on scene, and I brought up the issues one of the employees, whom I advised that I would be setting up a meeting with the licensee at a future date to address the issues. I took several photos depicting the poor condition of the property and attached them to this report. DNS Inspector Willis Neal also responded to the location to issue clean-up orders at the location, and to have the storage trailer removed. The 1800 block of W Greenfield Av is known to be a hotspot for prostitution and drug activity, and while at the property I observed several suspicious vehicles pulling into the gas station, observing our marked police squad car, then abruptly leaving.

This report is written by P.O. Kevin VODICKA assigned to District Two, Day Shift Community Prosecution Unit. On Wednesday, December 9, 2020, at 10:48 AM, Squad 2166 (P.O. Matthew DIENER and I) and Wisconsin Depart of Revenue Agent Georgeann KING conducted a licensed premises check at Alina Petroleum, located at 1801 W Greenfield Av, after having received complaints that the location had video gambling machines and that subjects were loitering in and around the business in order to take money out of the A.T.M. in order to gamble.

Officers entered the location and observed two (2) video machines near the bac of the location. The machines appear to traditional video gambling machines; however, a customer has the option of pressing a small button on the screen, after having inserted at least one (1) U.S. dollar, which shows the customer if the machine is going to award a monetary prize. The customer then has the option to have their money returned to them or to continue to play. The customer receives a payout slip (if owed money) and are payed by the employee. The machines are rented from a vendor, JD Prime Games, and proceeds from the games are split between the premises and JD Prime Games.

A check of displayed licenses revealed that the premises does not hold a PEP license. Officers found no violations during the check. Agent KING seized seven (7) boxes of tobacco products that were purchased from an unauthorized distributer. Officers and Agent KING spoke with the licensee, Muhammad RANA (A/M 04/15/55) by phone during the investigation.

A citation for PEP license required was issued and mailed to the licensee.



Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
