File # 020164 is a resolution relative to acceptance and funding of the Fight Asthma Milwaukee Allies Grant.

Background

1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) to accept and fund the Fight Asthma Milwaukee Allies Grant project from Children's Hospital of Wisconsin (CHW).
2. This is a new grant.

Discussion

1. The purpose of this project will be to support care coordination and case management for children who receive emergency department services due to the severity of their asthma.
2. The monitoring of, and assurance of care for pediatric asthma cases is a strategic priority for MHD's Home Environmental Health and Maternal and Child Health Divisions.
3. This subcontract will allow MHD to develop the service infrastructure needed to serve families impacted by asthma through care coordination and case management.
4. This grant project intends to work toward the reduction of hospitalizations and emergency room visits relative to pediatric asthma.
5. MHD staff will identify families eligible for these services and measure the effectiveness of these services through pre/post surveys regarding parent and children quality of life relative to care coordination and case management. The care coordinator will monitor data and provide care coordination on a citywide basis working with CHW and various HMO providers.
6. This grant encompasses the period of January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002.

Fiscal Impact

1. The total amount of this grant is \$66,826, entirely from the grantor.

2. This grant (94%) will fund the following MHD positions with salary and fringe benefits:
 - 1 *new* Care Coordinator, SG 03 or 04 (This position has not yet been classified)
 - 1 *existing* Office Assistant II (0.2 FTE), SG 410
3. CHW has assured funding for this project for three years.
