This is in response to your request on behalf of local residents to install the above-captioned parking restriction.

Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found east bound motorists on East Norwich Street have a difficult time seeing traffic traveling north bound on South Pine Avenue when vehicles park close to the corner. Therefore, in the interest of public safety, we recommend installing the above-captioned parking restriction to increase cross traffic visibility at the intersection.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
