
Dear Charles Montgomery:

This is to notify you that on Wednesday, November 11, 2020, the Public Works Committee voted to recommend to the Common Council to deny your application for a Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's License based on your second nonappearance.

On Tuesday, November 24, 2020, the Common Council considered the Committee's recommendation regarding your application. On that date, the Common Council adopted the Committee's recommendation and denied the Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's License Application based on your second nonappearance.

If you previously paid the license fees you may be eligible for a refund, except for a portion of the fee that may be retained, by bringing in the receipt or filing an application for a refund within one year to date of Common Council action with the License Division, Room 105, City Hall.

Dear Moranda Johnson:

This is to notify you that on Wednesday, November 11, 2020, the City's Public Works Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council denial of your Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's license upon your second nonappearance despite being provided timely notice of the hearing.

On November 13, 2020, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Public Works Committee with respect to the renewal application for your Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's license in which the Committee recommended that the license be denied based upon your second nonappearance. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Tuesday, November 24, 2020 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did not appear, and you did not file written objections to the report of the Public Works Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Public Works Committee, the Common Council voted to deny your Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's license based upon your nonappearance.

If you previously paid the license fees you may be eligible for a refund, except for a portion of the fee that may be retained, by bringing in the receipt or filing an application for a refund within one year to date of Common Council action with the License Division, Room 105, City Hall.
