A parking auditor and facilities maintenance person conduct checks at the lot daily.

I gave the agent self-stick police contact cards that he places on the pay station for public view.

This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 02/04/2016 a representative of The Brass Alley (1023 North Old World Third Street) took part in training given by Milwaukee police officers at 2321 North Murray Avenue (The Winchester) regarding the use and identification of fake identification.

=====

2. On 08/05/2016 at 2:20am officers observed two patrons inside The Brass Alley Tavern, 1023 N. Old World Third St after closing time. PA33 filed no citation issued.
3. On 10/01/2016 at 11:28pm officers were flagged down for a fight at 1023 N. Old World Third St. The officers found a male outside of The Brass Alley bleeding from the head. He stated he was inside and got into a fight. He was knocked to the ground and struck over the head with a glass beer bottle. He was extremely upset stating employees never intervened. The actors fled the scene before anyone realized he was injured. The on duty manager, Brian WESTON, stated he was short staffed due to two sick calls. He was not aware of the incident because he was working in the back of the bar. He was advised he should have more staff on busy weekends.
4. On 03/31/2017 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 1. An underage Police Aid attempted to gain entry to The Brass Alley, 1023 N. Old World Third St. The Police Aid was not allowed entry by security at the door.

5. On 01/01/2018 an officer was investigating a sexual assault complaint. The victim was 20 years of age and was working at Red White & Blue on the night of 01/01/2018. The investigation revealed the victim went out with friends after work to The Brass Alley, which was confirmed on video surveillance. The investigation revealed the complaint was baseless. The applicant was cited for Allow Underage on Premise.

6. On 01/02/2018 an officer was conducting follow up on the incident from 01/01/2018. The officer spoke with Daniel EWING, who stated he was the manager. The officer asked for video surveillance, but EWING did not have access to the system. The officer checked licenses and found the bartender, Jonathan DOLLAR, who was working the lower bar, was not licensed. Old World Third St. The officer entered and the manager, Sonja BURTON, pointed out the females in the rear area of the bar stating she did not think they were old enough to be in the bar. The officer stopped the females and he found that all of the females were 18 years old and had obtained fake ID cards over the internet. The officer showed the ID cards to the security officer at the door who did not have any indication the ID's were fraudulent.
11. On 09/19/2018 at 2:44am officers observed a female laying on the ground at N. Old World Third St and W. Juneau St. The female was 19 years old and stated she lost her wallet inside The Brass Alley where she was drinking all night with her friend. On Saturday August 3rd from 7:00 PM to 3:00 AM squad 1430 was assigned to patrol the area of Old World Third Street between West State Street and West Juneau Avenue as code red officers during the operation of taverns during tavern hours. Our objective on code red is to maintain a sense of order within the area assigned and to assist citizens and taverns within our area as needed.

At approximately 2:09 AM, several squads were dispatched to Trio located at 1023 North Old World Third Street for a battery complaint. The battery victim Jerome S. CHRISTMAS (M/B 07/17/1993) was struck by Alonzo A. BEETS (M/B 06/09/1981). CHRISTMAS did lose consciousness after being struck by BEETS and did sustain a laceration to the back of his head. During the investigation it was discovered BEETS is an employee of Trio and had been assigned to work the front door of the tavern as security. Squads present during the investigation were:

Police Officer Joseph LACROIX did investigate the battery complaint and BEETS was arrested on scene for the battery. A detailed substantial battery report was written by PO LACROIX and other officers assisting in the investigation. The report was filed under case number 192160023.

## FOLLOW UP OF BATTERY

I conducted follow up of the incident to obtain the video surveillance from the incident at 8:00 PM on 08/03/2019. Prior to attempting to download the video for evidence manager Daniel L. EWING (M/W 02/01/1985) did play the video for PO SARDINA and I. I observed a disturbance inside TRIO that was pushed out into the street directly in front of the business. At approximately 2:01 on the video time stamp I observed CHRISTMAS standing next to BEETS on the sidewalk in front of the front door of TRIO. CHRISTMAS was positioned in close proximity to BEETS near his left shoulder area. It appeared as if CHRISTMAS and BEETS were having a discussion. The video does not have sound on playback.

After approximately 1 minute CHRISTMAS and BEETS remained in the same relative position. While observing the video it appeared as if the incident that occurred inside had cooled off and the discussion continued. On video I observed BEETS without cause or warning strike CHRISTMAS once with a closed fist in his head. I observed CHRISTMAS did fall backwards onto the sidewalk and did not move for several moments. It appeared as if CHRISTMAS lost all consciousness after being struck by BEETS.

This report is written by Police Officer Jesse MATTSON, assigned to District #1 on late power shift on squad car 1430. My primary duties on weekends are to participate on Code Red deployments. Code red deployments are the placement of uniformed police within the entertainment districts to maintain order and safety during bar hours. Duties include monitoring the operation of licensed businesses to include inspections.

On Sunday September 13, 2018 at approximately 11:30 pm, I was deployed at 1044 North Old World Third Street. Police Officer Christine GONZALEZ and I were conducting a foot patrol of the immediate area. PO GONZALEZ and I were monitoring the door of Club RWB at 1044 N. Old World Third Street when I observed an Uber or Lyft stop in front of Club RWB. I observed 7 young females get out of the Uber and they looked directly at me and then ran across the street into The Brass Alley located at 1023 N. Old World Third Street. Based on my experience on code red I suspected the 7 females may not have been old enough to enter a tavern.

When I arrived at the Brass Alley I observed the business was relatively slow. I observed potentially 22-25 customers within the license premise. I could not observe the seven young looking females while looking through the windows and door on the entryway. I entered the brass alley to conduct identification card checks of the seven females if I could locate them. I observed they were sitting in the rear bar which is not visible from the street. I walked into the rear room of the tavern and five of the seven females got up and ran into the ladies bathroom.

Also when I entered the rear room the manager Sonja Burton approached me and pointed where the seven girls were sitting at the bar and she said I don't think these girls are old enough to be in here. I conducted an interview with one of the females that did not run into the bathroom and it was discovered she was 18 years old. I also discovered while interviewing the female she had used a fraudulent identification card she had purchased on the internet for \$50 to get into the tavern.

I eventually interviewed all seven of the females and I found out they were we were all 18 years old and freshman at Marquette University. All seven had used the fraudulent ID to enter the tavern.

I interviewed the staff working at the front door and I had shown him the seven identification cards that I had confiscated from the juveniles. The doorman did not have any indication that the ID cards that were presented to him by the females to enter the bar where fraudulent.

While on scene I did advise the bar manager a Tavern report would be written regarding this incident.



I am sending you this email because I consider Milwaukee my hometown and visit the downtown area frequently, including to take the train to Chicago.

On Monday I paid \$8 for parking for the day at the parking lot that is just to the west of the Intermodal station. When I returned to my car at around 6:30 PM, there was a Notice on my car that stated that I had failed to pay for parking.

When I looked at my parking receipt, I noticed that the machine that took my payment did not accept the first digit I had entered and recorded my license plate number without the first digit.

I tried calling the parking company, Parking Revenue Recovery. The phone number they provide does not work. I emailed them my proof of payment and received an auto-reply stating that they would reply within 10 days. I am waiting.

I have heard about this company, and that I will end up being charged for this because technically, the machine did not have my license number correct.

They should need to prove then that I did not pay---vs. me needing to prove that I paid. I paid to park here!!!

Common sense will tell you that I paid and I should not have to pay to park \$8 plus another \$55 for their fine. This seems illegal. It also seems like they should do more to alert patrons of their practices or help customers to know when they may have entered a number incorrectly.

Ultimately, I can't ever trust this company not to rip me off again so I cannot park here again—Sturtevant will be my next choice.

Another thing to fear about Milwaukee.

Is this the way downtown Milwaukee wants to treat its visitors who invest in the downtown economy?

Anything you can do to help I will appreciate. I am a public employee who cannot afford to pay \$63 to park my car.


