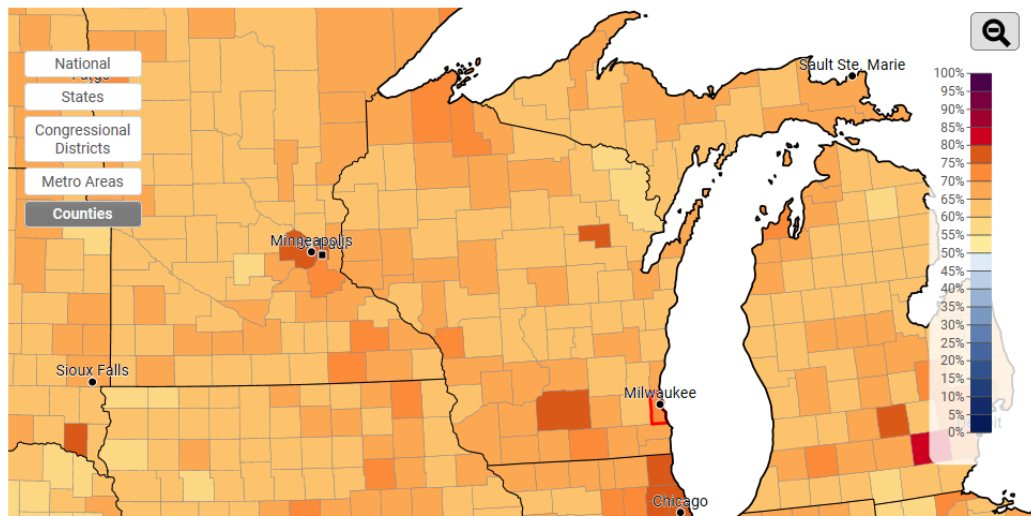

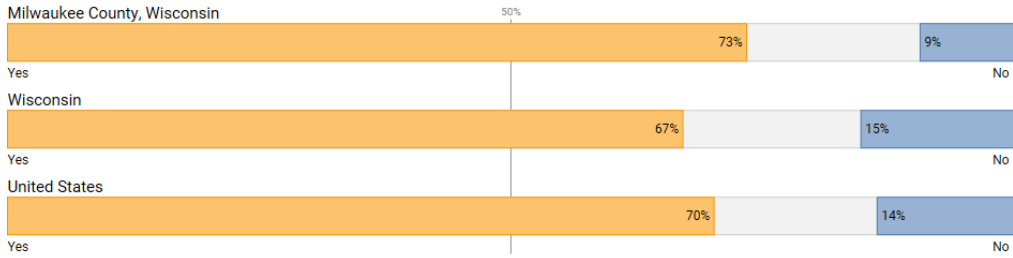

Estimated % of adults who think global warming is happening, 2018

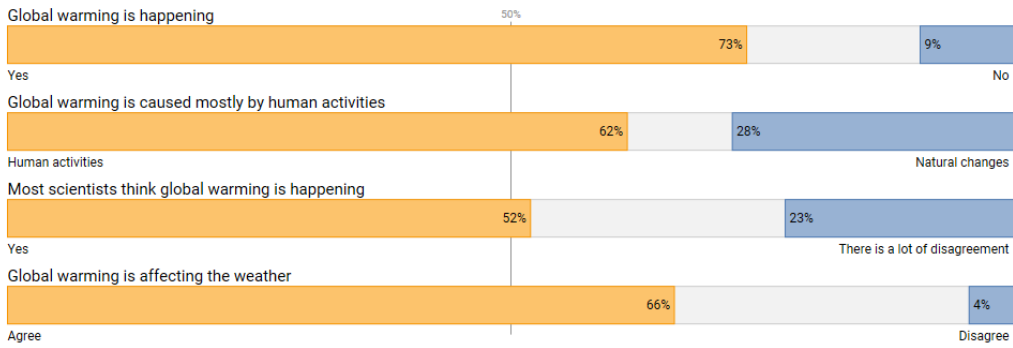

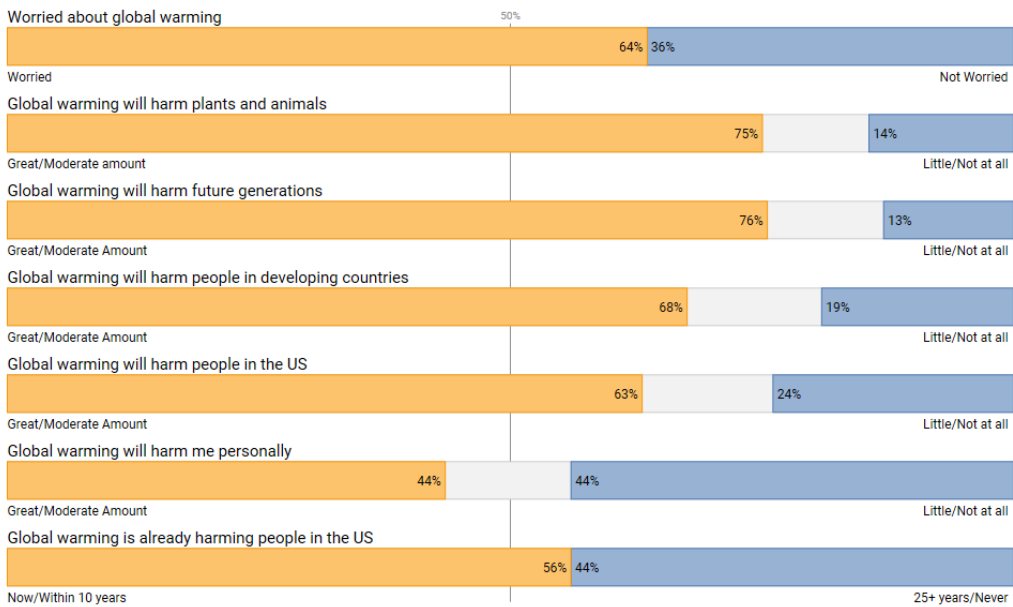


Public Opinion Estimates, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, 2018

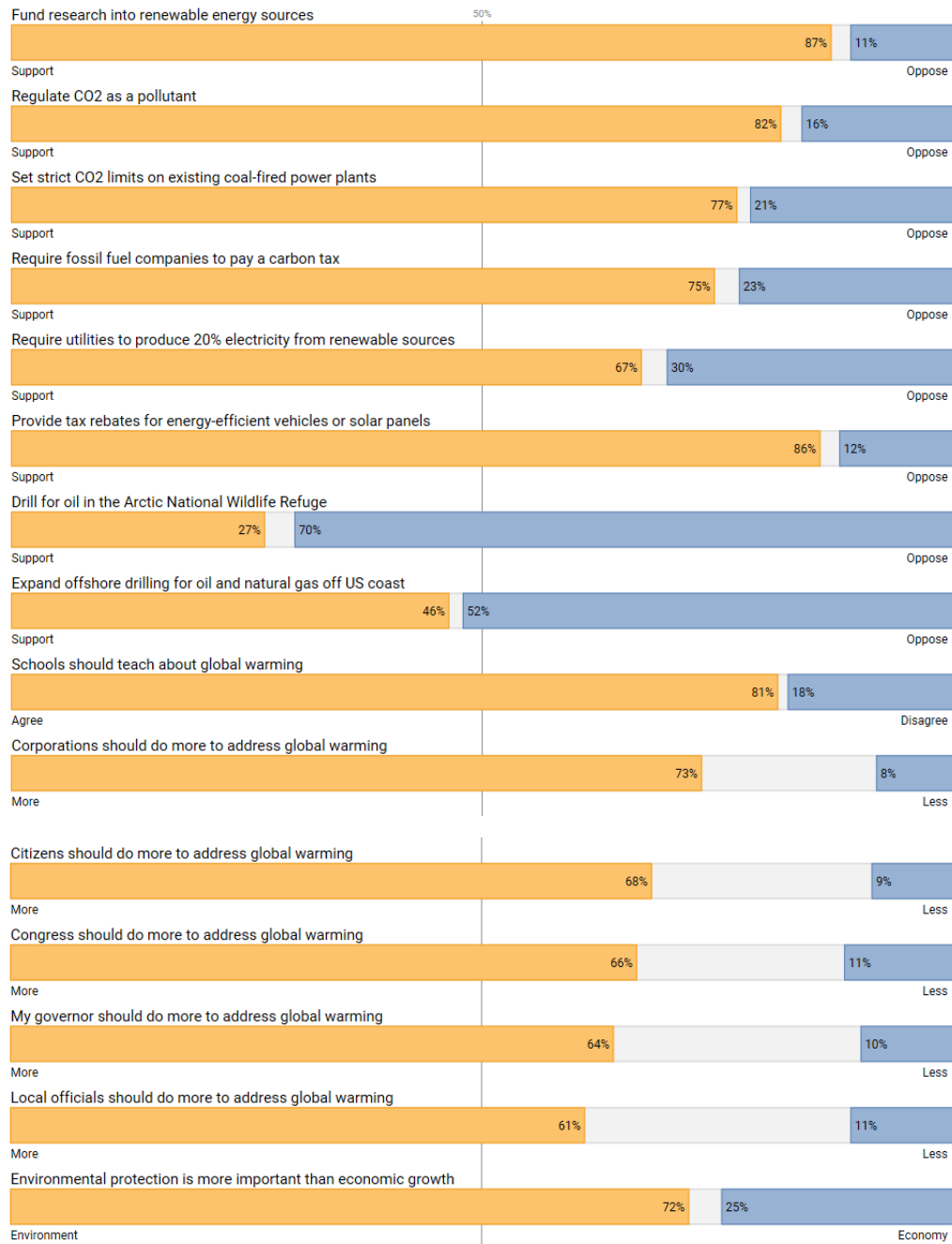

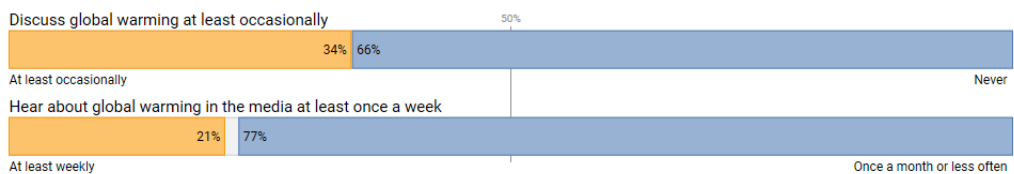

About the Data

Public opinion estimates are produced using a statistical model based on national survey data (n > 22,000) gathered between 2008 and 2018 by the [Yale Program on Climate Change Communication](#) and the [George Mason Center for Climate Change Communication](#). Positive (e.g., “Agree” or “Support”) and negative (“Disagree” or “Oppose”) responses are modeled separately; the light grey space on the bar charts therefore reflects respondents who marked “I don’t know”, “Not sure”, “Refused”, or similar options.
