To the Honorable, the Common Council City of Milwaukee

Dear Council Members:

Section 309-51 of the Milwaukee Code, relating to rules for the administration of sewer user charges, directs the City Comptroller to establish sewer user charge rates. Under this ordinance, the City is to pass through rate changes imposed by the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD), while also providing for the cost of administering the sewer user charge.

This letter is to inform you that the revised sewer user rates are effective with bills generated February, 2005. accordance with Section 309-51 of the Milwaukee Code, the connection charge and consumption charge portion of the revised rate now reflect those charges as billed by MMSD to the City. The administrative charge has been revised to reflect the City's current cost of administering the sewer user charge. The rates compare as follows:
