## AGREEMENT ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SISTER CITY RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE CITY OF ZADAR AND THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE

Starting from the existing friendly relations between the Republic of Croatia and the United States of America, and already established relations between the City of Zadar and the City of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, promoting shared values of freedom and democracy, and respecting the diversity of peoples and cultures, in accordance with the policies of the Sister Cities International Inc., established by the President of the United States of America in 1956, we aim to encourage greater friendship and achieve comprehensive cooperation between our communities, for the benefit of all citizens.

It is our common desire and intention to develop friendship and comprehensive cooperation between our two cities, thus attaining a common interest in improving educational, economic and cultural development of the two cities.

In particular, we will strive for the promotion and development of all forms of cooperation in the fields of: business, culture, health care, education, tourism and other areas of interest to both cities for their overall progress.

We will develop friendly ties especially encouraging exchanges between citizens, based on equality and mutual interest, friendship and mutual understanding, in order to improve the quality of life of the citizens in our cities, and empower the ideas of democracy and unity.

We herewith confirm with our signatures that this Agreement composed in Croatian and English language means the establishment of friendship and cooperation between the City of Zadar and the City of Milwaukee.
