There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 01/08/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 3219 South 13th Street (Buck Shots). During this check, behavior by one of the patrons caused officers to believe he was armed. A pat down by officers revealed this patron was concealing a pair of brass knuckles and a glass tube containing copper scrub at both ends. This patron was arrested. Milwaukee police incident report #150080070.

2. On 04/10/2016 Milwaukee police conducted a tavern check at 3219 South 13th Street (Buckshots Bar) after responding to a trouble with a subject complaint. No violations were observed.

=====

3. On 05/19/2018 officers were dispatched to a battery complaint at Buckshots Bar, 3219 S 13th St. The victim stated she confronted subjects in the bar that she believed were scamming other patrons. The subjects started arguing with the victim inside and continued outside. The victim stated she was hit in the head with a pistol by one of the subjects. The battery occurred in the alley outside of camera view. The applicant was on scene and cooperative. The officers were unable to obtain a copy of the video. MPD report filed.

4. On 06/21/2019 at 2:08am officers were dispatched to a shooting call at 3202 S 13th St. the officers located blood splatter in front of Buckshot's Bar, 3219 S 13th St. The officers interviewed the applicant who initially stated there were subjects kick out of the bar for being disorderly. He then stated the bar was closed and there was a fight outside which he witnessed but it was unrelated to the bar. Another employee, Viviana SEDA, stated she did not know anything about the incident outside, then stated she heard something about someone grabbing another patron, which caused a problem between patrons of the bar. The officers located two shell casings in the street across from the bar.

5. On 06/24/2019 at 4:05pm officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at Buckshot's Bar, 3219 S 13th St. The officers spoke with the caller who is a US Postal carrier. She stated that as she was delivering mail to Buckshot's a subject, who appeared to be intoxicated, came up to her and took the mail. The subject then asked her to kiss him and when she refused he grabbed her hand. The officers were able to identify the subject based upon information obtained from other patrons and issued the subject a Disorderly Conduct citation.

6. On 08/18/2019 at 2:20am officers were dispatched to a fight at 3228 S 13th St. When the officers arrived they found an accident at the location and a subject in front of Buckshots, 3219 S 13th St. bleeding from the mouth. The victim stated he was at Buckshots and got into a verbal altercation with another patron. As he was leaving he was assaulted and the assault continued outside. The victim then attempted to drive off and struck a parked car. The officer contacted the applicant on a later date and obtained the video of the incident.

7. On 09/16/2019 an officer conducted follow up from a call on 09/07/2019 regarding a fight at Buckshots, 3219 S 13th St. The officer spoke with a neighbor who stated there was a large group of people fighting outside of Buckshots that night. She stated she has called the Police in the past for similar incidents. The officer spoke to another neighbor who stated she was awoken by the large fight and she called the police. She said the subjects left just prior to the arrival of the police. She stated she observed the owner of the bar standing outside watching the fight but he did nothing to stop the fight. He then drove off with the subjects just prior to the arrival of the police.

8. On 10/06/2019 at 1:01am officers were flagged down at Buckshots, 3219 S 13th St. by the applicant regarding a Trouble with Subject. The applicant pointed out a subject walking away that had been involved in a fight inside the tavern. The subject stopped and talked with police. The applicant stated the other party had already left and he did not want to prosecute. The subject was allowed to leave in a cab.

9. On 10/13/2019 at 2:20am officers were dispatched to Shots fired at 3224 S 13th St. The officer determined this to be related the patrons leaving Buckshots, 3219 S 13th St. The officer interviewed the applicant who stated he was closing the bar at 2:10am and had to escort out 30-40 people. He observed a fight outside and he went to break it up. When he was back inside he heard several shots fired outside. The applicant provide video to the officers. While on scene a shooting victim arrived at St Lukes hospital. This subject stated he was at the bar for about 1 hour before the fight started. The victim went outside and joined in the fight. After the applicant broke up the fight the victim was walking off when someone fired shots, striking him in the leg. The victim was 20 years old and the applicant was cited for Allow Underage on Premise.

Charge: Allow Underage on Premise

Finding: Guilty

10. On 10/18/2019 at 10:12pm officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 6. An underage Police Aide able to gain entry to Buckshots, 3219 S 13th St. At the bar the Police Aide ordered a beer from the applicant. The applicant asked for ID and when the Police Aide could not show ID the applicant kicked him out.

11. On 11/07/2019 a meeting was held at District 6 regarding Buckshots, 3219 S 13th St. The applicant stated he has been in business for many years at this location and he has noticed as other bars close, his clientele gets younger. The applicant stated he has raised his drink prices and has noticed a decrease in sales but hopes the problems will decrease. The applicant provided a letter stating changes he would make including: ID every patron after 10pm; having a bouncer at the door scanning for weapons and maintaining capacity; closing 30 minutes early to disperse crowds and calling the police to report any problems. The applicant also stated he would have the bouncer prevent large crowds from forming outside. The applicant was cooperative and was willing to work to keep peace in the neighborhood.

12. On 02/22/2020 at 7:59pm officers were dispatched to a fight in the area of S 13th St and W. Euclid Av. When the officers arrived they observed multiple intoxicated subjects in front of Buckshots, 3219 S 13th St. The officer spoke with one bartender who stated he did not see anything. The officer spoke with the manager who stated there was a birthday party that day and there was a group that started to argue. When the subjects started fighting they were pushed outside. The manager stated she was one of the people that called the police. The officers could not locate any of the subjects injured or admitting to be in the fight.

13. On 11/06/20 at 8:35pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 3219 S. 13th Street. The employee was cooperative and all their papers were in order.

14. On 09/16/20 at 7:31pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 3219 S. 13th Street. The employee was cooperative and all their papers were in order.

15. On 10/15/20 at 4:50pm, Milwaukee Police conducted follow-up regarding a ten day suspension handed down by the Milwaukee Common Council at 3219 S. 13th Street. Upon arrival, officers did observe that the tavern was still operating and the applicant stated he received a letter in the mail today (10/15/20) and that he planned on closing his establishment and cooperating with the suspension notice. All patrons were asked to leave due to the suspension and the applicant was respectful and receptive during the follow-up investigation.

16. On 07/22/21 at 11:59pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3219 S. 13th Street for a battery complaint. Investigation revealed that no battery occurred.

17. On 10/30/21, officers conducted a license premise check at Buckshot's, 3219 S. 13th St. All licenses were valid and no violations were found.
18. On 03/06/22 at 2:08am, A police officer observed patrons exit the bar at 3219 S. 13th St., and begin to physically fight. Upon the officer activating the emergency lights and air horn, most of the crowd dispersed. Officers interviewed the bartender who stated a few patrons began to cause trouble inside the bar, and upon exiting the bar, a physical fight ensued. Officers observed the bar appeared to be over capacity and interviewed the agent, who was on scene. The agent stated it was his birthday and invited a few people and admitted the bar became overcrowded. The agent and bartender were cooperative with the investigation and agreed to close the bar early. Two patrons were arrested for refusing to leave despite the agents request.

19. On 06/08/23 at 2:55a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 3219 S. 13th St. On arrival the bar was closed and the officer was unable to contact anyone.

20. On 06/25/23 at 2:20a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting at 3219 S. 13th St. On arrival, officers observed the victim, not breathing, with a single gunshot wound to their chest. Life saving measures by MPD and MFD were unsuccessful. The agent was very cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident. Investigation revealed the victim was inside the bar with the suspects. Once the patrons left the establishment a physical altercation transpired outside in which the victim was not involved in. As the actors involved in the fight began to walk away, the victim is seen backing up slowly and one of the actors fired several rounds at the victim, striking him.

21. On 06/25/23 at 4:19p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Gun at 3219 S. 13th St. Upon arrival officers observed approximately 10 subjects outside of the bar. The officers were advised the subjects with guns had already left the location. The agent was on scene and stated they had been working all day monitoring a vigil that was being held outside for a homicide victim. Officers did not view video surveillance of the incident.

This report is being written by PO Nash DATHE, assigned to District 6, late shift, off group 10.

On June 25th, 2023, at 2:24 am, Squad 6350 (PO GARCIA and Myself) were dispatched to Buck Shots Bar located at 3219 S 13th St in the City and County of Milwaukee for a shooting.

Upon arrival I made contact with the shooting Victim who was later identified as Leroy D. PRICE (B/M, 02/13/1992) who was laying on the ground in front of 3229 S 13th St. PRICE was not breathing with a single gunshot wound to the center of his chest. I started life saving measures until MFD arrived on scene to take over. Life saving measures were unsuccessful.

I then spoke to the owner of Buck Shots Bar David NUNEZ-CRUZ (W/M, 03/06/1961) who provided me access to the camera system. CRUZ also stated he was closing up the bar after all the patrons had left when he heard several gunshots (unknown how many). CRUZ cooperative with the entire investigation even allowing officers to have his phone on their person while reviewing the surveillance footage. CRUZ runs security at the door of the bar by checking identification upon entry. No one at the location is armed while working. CRUZ was cooperative and helped provide the footage of the incident captured on his cameras.

I reviewed the camera footage of the incident. The victim PRICE was inside of the bar with several patrons including the later identified shooters with which it appeared he was having a conversation with. No altercations were observed inside of the bar. Once the patrons had left the bar, a physical altercation had broken out in the street outside of the bar. 3-4 unknown black male actors got into a physical altercation with the victim PRICE standing approximately 5 feet away. It is unknown if PRICE was attempting to deescalate the situation. Then 3-4 actors began walking North Bound from the location away from the bar as PRICE began to back up slowly away from the incident which he never was physically involved with. One of the unknown males then fired several rounds in the direction of PRICE. PRICE can then be seen holding his chest and running from the scene Southbound before collapsing in front of 3229 S 13th St.

All employees and the business have active licenses. I did not observe any violations while on scene regarding the business or employees.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 11/7/2023 at 11:35 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.


