
Dear Commissioners:

**PERSONNEL ORDER 2019-50**

March 26, 2019

RE: DISCIPLINARY ACTION

POLICE SERGEANT DANIEL C. DZIEVIT, (010967), Property Control Division, charged with violation of department Core Values as follows:

Core Value 3.00– Integrity, referencing Guiding Principle 3.05: Failure to obey the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

The charge having been substantiated, he is found guilty as charged and the penalty adjudged appropriate by the Chief of Police is as follows:

Failure to obey the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

Thirty (30) day suspension without pay.

The Chief hereby orders that ten (10) of the thirty (30) day suspension without pay be held in abeyance for twelve (12) months, contingent upon successful participation in the Milwaukee Police Department's Operating While Intoxicated Committee. The Chief further orders that the remaining twenty (20) day suspension, if not appealed, shall be served during the following periods: April 29, 2019 through May 10, 2019; and May 27, 2019 through June 7, 2019.
