File Number 071117 is a resolution approving a Cooperation and Development Agreement between the City of Milwaukee and the Milwaukee Economic Development Corporation relating to a \$100,000 forgivable loan to Astronautics Corporation of America, Inc.

Background

- 1. Astronautics Corporation of America, Inc., is headquartered at 4115 North Teutonia Avenue and has its main production facility at 1412 West National Avenue. Astronautics has approximately 550 full-time employees at these two locations.
- 2. Astronautics' major product lines include aircraft cockpit avionics systems, navigational systems, flight instruments, flat panel displays, and mission and display processors.
- 3. Astronautics is currently recruiting over 70 professional, engineering, technical and production positions for its Milwaukee facilities as a result of new contracts it has recently secured with Boeing and other customers.
- 4. The Development Fund is a Department of City Development-administered capital account that provides financial assistance for development projects that do not qualify for tax incremental district designation. The Fund has been used to support façade-improvement grants and loans, brownfield cleanups, business improvement district activities, new home incentives and neighborhood street improvements.
- 5. The 2008 Adopted Budget provides \$1.8 million for the Development Fund.

Discussion

- 1. This resolution authorizes the proper City officials to enter into a Cooperation and Development Agreement with the Milwaukee Economic Development Corporation for the purpose of making a \$100,000 forgivable loan to Astronautics Corporation of America, Inc. A draft of the Cooperation and Development Agreement is attached to File Number 071117.
- 2. The Term Sheet for the proposed loan to Astronautics includes the following provisions:
 - Interest rate of 5.0%
 - Term of 10 years
 - Annual loan payments of principal (\$10,000 per year) and accrued interest

- Annual loan payments shall be forgiven each year that Astronautics maintains at least 525 full-time positions at its two Milwaukee facilities.
- Astronautics shall make its best effort to utilize Emerging Business Enterprises for 18% of the project cost.
- 3. This loan is intended to assist Astronautics in employee recruitment, specifically by funding building and parking lot security enhancements at its facilities. Planned security upgrades, which have a total cost of \$192,580, include: installation of burglar alarm, electronic card access and outdoor video surveillance systems; improvement of fencing and pedestrian access; reconfiguration of parking lots to increase capacity.
- 4. The City will provide \$100,000 from the DCD Development Fund to MEDC to fund the loan.

Fiscal Impact

The impact of this resolution will be a reduction of the balance in the Development Fund by \$100,000.
