Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit. Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 06/23/12 at 1:20 am, Milwaukee police conducted a license premise check at 5321 W Green Tree Rd and observed no violations.

- 2. On 08/30/12 at 10:59 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 5321 W Green Tree for a Subject With Gun complaint. Police spoke with the bartender Kelly Basquez and the manager Terrance Anderson. Investigation revealed a patron who was "buzzed" into the bar was asked to leave because in the past he had caused problems. A verbal argument started between the subject and Anderson outside of the bar, with the patron walking towards the parking lot. The subject then pulled up his shirt and pointed towards his pocket with Anderson observing a gun. The subject then stated, "Don't push me, I have a gun and the permit to carry it" in a non-threatening manner. Anderson stated he disengaged and walked back into the tavern where he called for police. Police did observe two signs posted that read, "Guns Prohibited" that could be easily seen as you walked to the bar. The manager declined to prosecute.
- 3. On the following dates and times, a license premise check was conducted with no violations being observed at the time.

09/02/12 1:00 am 09/09/12 12:45 am 09/29/12 12:40 am 12/01/12 1:00 am

- 4. On 03/09/13 at 2:05 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 5321 W Green Tree for a Shots Fired complaint. Officers spoke with Lynn Goelzer and the bartender Darriel Anderson who stated that a group of females were physically fighting inside the bar, which continued out in the parking lot after they were escorted out by security. It was then that an unknown male fired nine shots into the air. Citations were issued to the subjects for disorderly conduct and vandalism.
- 5. On 04/07/13 at 1:30 am, Milwaukee police conducted a License Premise Check at 5321 W Green Tree. As police arrived, they observed a security guard forcefully removing a subject from the bar. This subject continued to fight with police and was placed into custody. Officers then spoke to the guard, identified as Edward Hamilton, who stated that the subject and his girlfriend were suggestively dancing, (rubbing up against one another) and were bumping into other patrons and that they were asked to stop. The patrons did not and were asked to leave with Hamilton escorting the female first out of the bar. The boyfriend then pushed Hamilton on his shoulders with Hamilton forcibly pushing both subjects out of the bar. The male subject was charged with disorderly conduct and possession of THC.
- 6. On 06/02/13 at 1:30 am, Milwaukee police conducted a License Premise Check at 5321 W Green Tree. Upon police arrival, they observed a full parking lot with autos also parked on W Green Tree. Investigation found that three patrons were under the age of 21 and that an employee at the door had not been checking ID's. Police spoke with Charles Anderson who was speaking to the subjects as police approached. Anderson stated he saw the subjects enter and immediately went to speak with them because they looked underage. Anderson was also upset at his employee for not checking their ID's at the door. Anderson informed officers that his bartenders are trained to also check ID's on subjects who appear to look under 21.
- 7. On 12/08/2013 Milwaukee police responded to a Subject with a Gun complaint at 5321 West Greentree Road (New Entertainers Bar). Investigation revealed there had been an argument in the parking lot of the business, but no firearm was involved. Milwaukee police incident report # 133400147 filed.
- 8. On 12/08/2013 Milwaukee police conducted follow up at 5321 West Greentree Road (New Entertainers Tavern). The applicants spouse told officers that around 12:30am, an intoxicated subject knocked over some drinks on a table which angered the customers sitting at the table. The intoxicated subject was told to leave the business.
- 9. On 12/29/2013 Milwaukee police responded to a Shooting at 5321 West Greentree Road (New Entertainers Night Club). Investigation revealed an unknown person discharged a firearm into the business, striking a patron in the arm and the hip. Milwaukee police incident report #133630022 filed.
- 10. On 01/22/2014 the applicant met with Milwaukee police at the Fourth District Police Station. This meeting was held to discuss incidents involving criminal activity at the business. The applicant expressed a desire to address the recent issues and outlined changes she would make to policies and practices at the business. The applicant was told to contact police with any additional questions or concerns she may have regarding her business.

NARRATIVE SECTION: This report is submitted by P.O. Toua THAO, assigned to District 4, Late Power Shift, Squad 4440.

On Friday, 12-08-13 at 1:26am, my partner (P.O. Roger WALKER) and I were dispatched to investigate a Subject with Gun complaint at the address of 5321 W Greentree RD (New Entertainers Bar), which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival, we did not observe anyone outside the premises. I then spoke with the owner, Charles D. ANDERSON (B/M, 08-04-61), who stated that he observed a few females outside in the parking lot arguing. ANDERSON stated that during the argument he did not observe anyone with a gun. ANDERSON stated that after the female individuals argued they all entered their own vehicles and left the parking lot prior to police arrival.

P.O. WALKER attempted to contact the unknown caller but the calls went straight to the callers voicemail.

During this investigation, it was determined that there were no firearm involved in this incident.

This report is submitted by P.O. Daniel PRIEWE who is assigned to District 4, Late Shift.

On Sunday December 8th 2013 at approximately 2:00 A.M. Squad 4368(P.O. Martinez MOORE and I) conducted follow up at the New Entertainers Tavern which is located at 5321 W. Green Tree Rd regarding an Injury/Accident and Battery investigation by Squad 4342(P.O. Ralph MCCLAIN). Upon arrival at the tavern, I observed only a few patrons inside as the employees were cleaning up and getting ready to close for the night. I spoke with Charles D. ANDERSON(M/B 8-4-61) who works at the tavern and who is the husband of the owner, Lynn M. GOELZER(F/U 6-24-56).

ANDERSON informed me that at approximately 12:30 A.M. an intoxicated male entered the tavern and began to take his coat off near a table on the north side of the bar. This subject swung his coat while taking it off and it knocked over some drinks that were on a table which angered the patrons who were sitting at the table. One of these patrons who was no longer on scene stood up and grabbed the intoxicated subject but no physical altercation occurred. ANDERSON observed the incident and walked towards the intoxicated subject to address the matter. The two subjects were separated and the intoxicated male was told to leave. He left by himself but stated that he was going to return which he never did.

ANDERSON informed me that the playback system on his cameras was not functioning so I was not able to check if the incident was captured on camera.

Darriel A. ANDERSON(F/B 12-20-82, 7451 W. Glenbrook Rd #302, (c) 430-6170) was bartending at the time but did not observe the incident.

PA-33E Narrative

This supplemental report was submitted by P.O. Martinez MOORE PS# 015951 assigned to District 4, Late Shift.

On Sunday, December 29, 2013, at 1:55 A.M., Squad 4368, P.O. Nathan WOODS and I, were dispatched to a shooting at 5321 W. Green Tree Rd, New Entertainers (Night Club). Upon arrival we observed several vehicles leaving from the west parking lot of New Entertainers. The vehicles were traveling hastily east and west on W Green Tree Rd. P.O. WOODS parked our City of Milwaukee marked Squad car (vehicle #14), on W Green Tree Rd, approximately 75 feet east of New Entertainers. We then exited the squad car and tactically approached the tavern.

Upon approach of New Entertainers, I observed two bullet holes through the double pane picture window, located on the north east side of the tavern. I then entered New Entertainers through the west entrance door (main patron entrance). After making my ingression into the west entrance door, I observed 5 citizens; 3 black females and 2 black males, scattered sporadically throughout New Entertainers. I immediately asked them if anyone was shot or in need of medical attention and they all replied "No."

After confirming that the aforementioned citizens were not injured, I began to separate the witnesses for interview integrity purposes. I also secured the scene for investigative purposes. The aforementioned citizens were identified as following:

Shalonda D BERRY B/F, 08-27-65 address of 2820 W Mill Rd #A; Milwaukee, WI 53209, cell phone# 324-5424. BERRY is a bartender for New Entertainers. Shalonda BERRY'S class "D" bartenders license number is 0207755, expiration date of 12-31-14.

Shawn M PARIS B/M, 05-13-90 address of 5336 N 34th St; Milwaukee, WI 53209, cell phone# 364-3734. PARIS is the Disc Jockey "DJ" for New Entertainers.

Charles D ANDERSON B/M, 08-04-61 address of 4333 Grace Ave; Mequon, WI 53092, cell phone# 228-235-9677. ANDERSON identified himself as the co-owner of New Entertainers. The owner, according to DNS property data, is Lynn M GOELZER W/F, 06-24-56 (same address and phone number as ANDERSON), class "B" tavern license number of 0201446, expiration date of 11-01-14.

Terrance Z ANDERSON B/M, 09-23-76 address of 8853 N Swan Rd #G; Milwaukee, WI 53224, cell phone# 265-9882. T. ANDERSON is the Security Officer for New Entertainers.

and Jamie U BASQUEZ B/F, 02-03-89 address of 3364 N Richards St #A; Milwaukee, WI 53212, phone#426-3513. BASQUEZ is a class "D" bartender for New Entertainers. BASQUEZ' bartender license number is 0203647, expiration date of 12-31-15.

After positive identification was made of the aforementioned New Entertainers employees, I, P.O. MOORE, conducted a preliminary interview of the co-owner, Charles ANDERSON. Succeeding my interview of Charles ANDERSON, my investigation revealed that an unknown actor discharged a firearm into New Entertainers, subsequently striking the double pane picture window, located on the north east side of the tavern. Charles ANDERSON was unaware if any of the patrons were shot, however he stated following the shots fired, a patron, who ran outside the tavern succeeding the shots being fired, stated she was shot and could not walk. ANDERSON stated that during this incident, patrons were running frantically out of the tavern and into their vehicles. He further stated that while addressing the crowd, the victim, identified as a B/F, 24, 5'6", 180, heavy built, shoulder

length hair, multi-colored vertical stripes on her shirt, and "daisy duke" pants; left the scene in an unknown vehicle, in an unknown direction.

After receiving aforementioned information, I received an update, from the dispatcher, that the victim, identified as Shantel L STONE B/F, 12-20-91 address of 9001 N 75th St #310; Milwaukee, WI 53223, B of I number 393905; was at St Joseph's Hospital, located at 5000 W Chambers St. Soon thereafter, P.O. Roger WALKER notified me that the victim sustained a gun shot wound to her right forearm and right hip.

After ascertaining all relevant and pertinent information pertaining to this shooting investigation, I then notified District 4 Shift Commander, Lieutenant Joseph SEITZ. Lt. SEITZ advised me that the Criminal Investigation Bureau (CIB) was notified. He further stated that CIB would be responding.

Upon CIB arrival, I then briefed Detective Luke ARDIS pertaining to the fruits of my preliminary investigation. Detective ARDIS then took over the scene as the primary investigator. I, P.O. MOORE, continued to assist with scene integrity throughout the duration of the investigation.

This concluded my involvement in this investigation.

PA-33E Narrative

This report was written by P.O Rufaro Davis, assigned to District Four, day shift.

On Wed., 1/22/14 I, along with Lt. Seymer- Tabaska, and Lt. Seitz met with the owner of New Entertainers, Lynn M. Goelzer at District Four Police Station. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the incidents that occurred involving criminal activity at the tavern. During the meeting Ms. Goelzer expressed her desire to address the recent issues regarding the incidents that transpired, and her willingness to change some of the practices and policies at her business. Goelzer stated since the recent closing of another tavern in the area, she has seen a change in the type of customers who patronize her business. She stated the crowd is much younger, and there have been a few problems with some of the younger crowd. Goelzer stated they do have an age restriction of 25 an older, but don't always enforce this policy. Goelzer stated in her efforts to change some of the current practices of the business she would begin to enforce the age restriction that she initially put in place, but didn't enforce. She stated her staff would begin to utilize the weapon detector they have by wanding customers as they enter the business, and checking purses or handbags. She also stated she would place more signage outside and inside the business which would include no loitering, no weapons, and no illegal activity.

Goelzer stated there are surveillance cameras, and they are currently in the process of updating the system.

I informed Goelzer to contact me with any additional concerns or questions she may have regarding her business.

Henning also stated she switched her computer technical support contract to another company and in doing so, stated that any future video should be available within 24 hours of an incident. Henning also stated to police that a regular patron she only knew as "Lucky" had indicated to her husband that he had knowledge regarding this incident and that no shooting took place in the parking lot. Henning stated that her husband was currently at the bar now, but was intoxicated and asked the police not interview him. Henning was advised that if "Lucky" were to

show up at the bar, to call police so he could be interviewed. The USB drive that contained the video footage was not viewable due to the computer not being compatible with Hennings video system. The drive was taken to Forensics where the examiner would convert the files.

14. On 08/11/14 at 12:30 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 7424 N 60th Street for a Theft complaint. Police spoke with the bartender Steve Sosman who advised officers that at 11:20 pm, two unknown males entered the bar and went by the juke box. This report is written by PO Alan BEATTIE, assigned to District 4, Early Shift.

On Sunday, 1-12-14, at 10:43 pm, squad 4220 (PO Jacob WASECHEK) and I (squad 4222) were dispatched to 7424 N 60th St, to investigate an armed robbery complaint.

Upon arrival I came into contact with one of the three victims, Keeton J SARTIN (B/M, 01-16-92). While on scene I was advised to interview SARTIN regarding the incident; SARTIN statement is as follows:

SARTIN stated at approximately 10:20 PM he was standing outside in the smoking area which is located on the southeast corner of the Brett's Farmhouse bar. SARTIN stated that he noticed 4 people walking north bound on the 7400 block of N 60th St, walking towards Brett's Farmhouse, but did not think anything was suspicious. SARTIN stated his cousin, Corey D O'LEARY (B/M 10-28-86) and his cousin's friend, Sean M LETHERWOOD (10-23-70) came out to the smoking area to smoke as well. SARTIN stated almost immediately after O'LEARY and LETHERWOOD came out the subjects came around from the front of the bar and walked up the ramp to the smoking area. SARTIN stated subject #1 was a B/M armed with a black rifle with a brown butt stock, possibly 22 caliber and looked like a Daisy BB gun, pointed it at LETHERWOOD and said "YALL KNOW WHAT IT IS, LAY IT DOWN." SARTIN stated O'LEARY and himself stated " NO WE DON'T KNOW WHAT IT IS." SARTIN stated subject #1 then said " WE CHECKING POCKETS." SARTIN stated subject #2 was also armed with a black rifle and had it pointed at them. SARTIN stated while subject #1 and subject #2 were pointing the rifles at them subject #3 went into LETHERWOODS pockets and took a black Nexus 7 tablet, black Iphone 4, and a set of keys. SARTIN stated subject #4 attempted to go into O'LEARY's and his pockets, but they stepped back and said "YOU AINT TAKING SHIT FROM ME." SARTIN also stated O'LEARY said " I GOT SOMETHING FOR YALL." SARTIN stated after O'LEARY made that statement, the 4 black males took off running, they headed north bound on N 60th St. SARTIN stated a few minutes after the incident happen, O'LEARY, LETHERWOOD and himself got into a vehicle and went after the subjects. SARTIN stated 2 of the subjects ran east bound from N 60th St onto the train tracks and the other 2 ran north east into an apartment complex area.

SARTIN stated he could only ID subject #1, which he describes as a B/M, 17 yoa, 5'5", 120-125lbs, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt with the hood over his head, black pants, and black Nike boots. SARTIN stated his focus was soley on subject #1 so he has no further description of the other 3 subjects. P.O. WASECHEK interviewed LETHERWOOD and has a better description of the subjects, P.O. WASECHEK will write a supplemental report. Squad 4229 (P.O. Kent GORDON and P.O. BRATCHETT) were also on scene and they interviewed O'LEARY and will file a supplemental report on that.

Taken from LETHERWOOD was a black Nexus 7 tablet with a gray case, black Iphone 4 (fully charged) and a set of keys.

This report is being written by P.O Michael BRAUNREITER assigned to squad 4340, District 4 late shift.

On Tuesday February 4 2014 at 12:11am my partner, P.O PRIEWE (018944), and I were dispatched to a Battery complaint at the Brett's Farmhouse Tavern located at 7424 N 60th St. Upon arrival we were unable to locate the caller (SANDERS, Sharon B/F 11/20/1968). We spoke with the Bartender/Owner (HENNING, Brett W/M 12/11/1958) who stated the two that were involved in the incident are regulars at the bar. When they first came in they both went into the bathroom and started arguing. He went into the bathroom and told the male subject (ABDURAHMAN, Dominic D W/M 03/01/1986) he couldn't be in the women's bathroom. After that both the subjects left the bathroom and continued to argue and "wrestle" in the corner of the tavern until he kicked them out.

P.O PRIEWE attempted to watch the video regarding the incident but was unable to access the video. P.O PRIEWE has prior contacts with these two individuals and we attempted to locate them at their home addresses but were unable to make contact.

This Milwaukee Police Department's, Report of Incidents Involving Licensed Persons or Premises report, was submitted by P.O. Martinez MOORE PS# 015951 assigned to District 4, Late Shift.

On Wednesday, February 26, 2014, at 3:02 A.M., I, Squad 4368, was dispatched to the scene of a shooting at 7424 N 60th St, Brett's Farmhouse. Upon my arrival, at 3:04 A.M., I was greeted by the owner, Brett A HENNING W/M, 12-11-58 address of 4322 W Woodale Av; Brown Deer, WI 53223, home phone# 371-9010. HENNING was the sole person inside the tavern. I then advised HENNING that I was currently at his tavern investigating a confirmed shooting. Brett HENNING immediately advised me that he was unaware of any shooting. HENNING further stated that he did not hear any shots fired. My interview of HENNING was conducted by the tavern's bar. Brett HENNING maintained a calm demeanor, was not under the influence of drugs or alcohol, and spoke well.

Interview of Brett A HENNING W/M, 12-11-58

Brett HENNING stated on Tuesday, February 25, 2014, at approximately 11:45 A.M., he entered Brett's Farmhouse to oversee the nightly operations of his tavern. HENNING stated that he was immediately advised by his bartender, identified as Michael M RYAN W/M, 10-16-47 address of 8856 N Greenvale Rd; Bayside WI 53217, cell phone# 354-4128, that there was a physical altercation inside the bar. RYAN advised HENNING that on Tuesday, February 25, 2014, at approximately 11:30 P.M., a patron named "Augie" was punched by a black male, approximately 300 to 350 pounds, no further description, for calling him a nigger.

HENNING stated that "Augie" has been a patron of Brett's Farmhouse for approximately 7 years. Brett HENNING described Augie as a white or fair complexion Hispanic male, 30's, 5'8", 190, bald, no facial hair, and no known scars, marks, or tattoos (unknown clothing). HENNING stated that he did not have knowledge of Augie's demographics. Brett HENNING further stated that his patrons present photographic identification prior to entering, however, HENNING stated that he does not have a photograph identification card reader.

Michael RYAN advised HENNING that the subject that assaulted Augie had left the tavern prior to his arrival. HENNING stated that he spoke to Augie pertaining to the fight. Brett HENNING stated that Augie was extremely intoxicated during their dialog. HENNING further stated that Augie was accompanied in the tavern by his girlfriend, Sarah. Sarah is described as a white female, 30's, no further description. Brett HENNING stated that Sarah is also a long time patron of Brett's Farmhouse. He further stated that he has constructive knowledge that Sarah is an employee of Olive Garden.

HENNING stated that Augie informed him of the detailed account of the incident. Brett HENNING stated that Augie made the succeeding statement.

Augie stated that the aforementioned black male approached them at the bar and began flirting with Sarah. Augie, at this time, became upset with the flirting then called the patron a nigger. The patron then retaliated by punching Augie once upon his forehead causing swelling above his left eye. The force of the punched caused Augie to fall to the floor. Augie was then assisted off the floor by Sarah then went to the bathroom. Sarah began engaging the patrons by calling them "thugs" and "gangsters." The black male patron then left the tavern.

HENNING stated that there was a ratio of approximately 30 blacks and 4 whites inside the tavern upon his arrival. Brett HENNING stated that he feared that Augie and Sarah were going to be assaulted for making racially derogatory statements. HENNING stated that once Augie came out the bathroom, he left the tavern with Sarah. Brett HENNING stated that they were not followed into the parking lot. HENNING stated that Augie and Sarah left the parking lot in an unknown vehicle without further incident. Brett HENNING was adamant that he did not see anyone get shot. HENNING was further adamant that he did not hear any shots

fired. HENNING stated that he does have a digital camera system, however does not possess the pass code. Brett HENNING then escorted me to the basement where I observed a live feed of his digital camera system.

HENNING'S digital camera system consists of 10 cameras, 9 are operational, and one is none functional. Brett HENNING'S cameras are positioned in the following locations.

Camera #1, mounted over the south entrance door (east wall); approximately 7 feet from the floor and has a view of the bar. Camera #1 face to the west.

Camera #2, mounted approximately 7 feet from the floor, on the west wall. Camera 2 has a view of the lounge area and game area (north side of tavern).

Camera #3, mounted on the exterior of the building, centrally located on the south side. Camera 3 faces south and has a view of the deck.

Camera #4, mounted approximately 7 feet from the floor on the west wall. Camera #4 has a view of the bar and face east.

Camera #5, mounted approximately 10 feet from the ground, on the southeast side of the building. Camera #5 has a view of the east side of the south parking lot.

Camera #6, none functional

Camera #7, mounted approximately 10 feet from the ground, on the southwest side of the building. Camera #7 has a view of the south west side of the parking lot.

Camera #8, mounted approximately 7 feet from the floor, on the east wall o the kitchen. Camera #8 face west bound and has a view of the kitchen.

Camera #9, mounted on the basement wall, has a view of the basement.

Camera #10, mounted on the basement wall, has a view of the basement.

There was no trace or physical evidence consistent of a shooting scene located in the south parking lot of Brett's Farmhouse. Augie's skin complexion is not consistent with the skin complexion of the shooting victim identified as Augusta A WALTON B/M, 10-28-81. WALTON is described as a dark complexion black male, as previously stated, Augie is described as a fair complexion white or Hispanic male.

Squad 4330, P.O. Daniel PRIEWE and Michael BRAUNREITER, were the preliminary investigators of this shooting investigation. Squad 9391, Detective Nicholas THOMAS; and Squad 9393, Detective Edmund FITTING, were briefed by Squad 4330, P.O. PRIEWE and BRAUNREITER, then took over as primary investigators.

A Synopsis of the investigation revealed the following:

On Wednesday, February 26, 2014, between approximately 12:30 A.M. and 2:00 A.M., the victim, identified as Augusta A WALTON B/M, 10-28-81 address of 2669 N 15th St; Milwaukee, WI 53206, cell phone# 400-1515, was a paton at Brett's Farmhouse, located at 7424 N 60th St, with an associate identified only as "Bankhead." WALTON stated that while Bankhead and he were patrons at Brett's Farmhouse, they did not have any confrontations with any other patrons. Augusta WALTON stated at approximately 2:00 A.M., while in the parking lot of Brett's Farmhouse, he felt a sharp pain and stinging sensation to his right hand. WALTON stated that he looked at his right hand then observed that he sustained a gunshot wound and observed a bullet protruding from his hand. Augusta WALTON stated he entered the vehicle of two unknown black females

(specifications of the vehicle unknown) then requested that they take him to the hospital. WALTON stated that the females drove him to Froedtert Hospital for medical attention. Augusta WALTON stated that there was no altercation in the parking lot, futher stated that he did not hear or see anyone discharing a firearm. WALTON was admitted at 2:55 A.M, and subsequently medically treated for a gunshot wound to his right hand by Dr. Timothy LENZ.

This synopsis was ascertained from Detective Nicholas JOHNSON'S original report pertaining to this investigation. Suspect for this shooting is unknown at this time.

This concludes my Report of Incidents Involving Licensed Persons or Premises report.

E Narrative

his report is being written by PO Carrie POCERNICH assigned to District Four, Early Shift.

On Monday, March 24, 2014, at 6:25 p.m., Sgt. Adam GROCHOWSKI and I conducted follow-up at Brett's Farmhouse, 7424 N 60th St, concerning a shooting investigation. The shooting investigation, as documented in incident report # 14-057-0015, was reported as having occurred on February 26th, 2014, at about 2:00 a.m.

Upon our arrival, Sgt. GROCHOWSKI and I were met by the owner of the establishment who identified herself as Ms. Janet L. HENNING (w/f 04-28-57) of 4322 W Woodale Av, Brown Deer, WI 53223, Ph # 418-1456. Ms. HENNING was found to be cooperative and advised us that she had previously met with Officer Kyle MROZINSKI, and arranged to be at the tavern on today's date to turn over security video footage from the date of the alleged shooting.

Ms. HENNING further related to officers the cause for the lengthy delay. HENNING stated that prior to the incident, she has been having router problems and a part time computer person. Due to those problems and that her work computers were down (as she runs a real estate brokerage), she was not able to efficiently retrieve the Brett's Farmhouse video.

Ms. HENNING did relate that she has the following security cameras:

Camera 1 - Side door / ramp

Camera 2 - Interior / Dining Area

Camera 3 - Outdoor deck

Camera 4 - Bar area

Camera 5 - Back parking lot near patio and outdoor picnic table

Camera 6 - Not working

Camera 7 - Front parking lot

Camera 8 - Kitchen

Ms. HENNING advised that Camera # 6 is not working but is scheduled to be fixed this week. Additionally, HENNING advised that she has since switched her computer technical support contract from a part-time person to a computer company iNET. In so doing, Ms. HENNING stated that any future video should be available within 24 hours of an incident.

Ms. HENNING's husband Brett was also on scene but Ms. HENNING stated that he was sitting at the bar (patron side) and was intoxicated. As such, Ms. HENNING requested police not interview him in his current state.

Ms. HENNING was not aware that the victim in this offense, whom she knows as "Auggie", was the victim of the shooting. HENNING was not advised of this fact, pending review of the video footage.

HENNING also provided officers with additional information that a regular patron, "Lucky", had indicated to her husband that he had knowledge regarding this incident and that no shooting took place in the parking lot. HENNING reiterated that her husband did not wish to speak with officers on today's date but was advised to call police if Lucky were to show up at the tavern to be interviewed.

Ms. HENNING gave me a USB drive that contained the video footage that we requested from her. I attempted to view the footage at District 4 and was unable to due to the computer not being compatible with her video system.

Nook the USB drive to B of I and met with Forensic Video Examiner Robbie LLOYD. FVE LLOYD at that he would convert the files on a disc for me and contact me when he was done.

This concludes my follow-up.

This report is written by P.O. Waseem SAROSH, Squad 4340, District 4, Late Shift.

On Monday, August 11, 2014, at approximately 12:30 AM, I, P.O. Waseem SAROSH and P.O. Daniel PRIEWE were dispatched to 7424 N. 60th St. which is in the city and county of Milwaukee to investigate a theft complaint.

Upon arrival, I talked to the bar tender, later identified as Steve H. SOSMAN (W/M 12/27/1954) who informed me that at approximately 11:20 PM on 08/10/2014 two unknown black males (suspect 1 and suspect 2) entered the tavern and went by the juke box. A short time later he recognized one of them and he confronted him about the theft of a liquor bottle that happened a few weeks prior which was never reported to police.

SOSMAN informed me that when he confronted suspect 1 (B/M, approximatey 24-26, 260 pounds, short dred locks and wearing a black shirt with pants) about the previous theft, suspect 1 gave SOSMAN 10 dollars and said it should cover it and he didn't steal anything. SOSMAN informed me that at this time, suspect 1 came behind the counter, which is for employees only, and took 1 bottle of Bacardi Lemon (64oz, \$35.00) and tossed it to the suspect 2. SOSMAN informed me that he pushed the suspect out from behind the bar towards the door and both suspects fled outside the door and entered a gold 4 DR vehicle with WI plates 223-VGJ. They proceeded to flee north bound on 60th street in the vehicle.

SOSMAN informed me that there was another unknown black male inside the vehicle. SOSMAN told me that he never consented to anyone to take the Bacardi bottle and would like to prosecute.

I was informed that the security cameras in the tavern were working but he did not know how to acess them. SOSMAN did not have a bartender's license on him nor was it posted. He informed me that the owner, Brett HENNING, had it but he was not currently at the tavern. P.O. PRIEWE contacted the District 4 console operator to verify if SOSMAN had a bartender's license. The L.I.R.A. site was having technical issues which took the console operator time to access. We proceeded with out investigation.

A DOT check on the vehicle revealed that the vehicle was listed Brittany L. SCOTT (B/F 03-13-1992, 7834 W. Silver Spring DR #104). The vehicle was a 02 Cheverolet Impala (SILV,DR, WI 223-VGJ, VIN 2G1WH55K9Y9108928). A check on the residence revealed that this located was invalid and this address did not exist. A check on SCOTT in the MILW PD booking system revealed a phone number. A call to this number was answered by unknown male who proceeded to hang up.

- P.O. PRIEWE and I returned to the tavern at approximately 2:15 A.M., which was closed. I spoke with SOSMAN and issued him a PV-17. The owner, HENNING, was on scene. He did not have SOSMAN's tavern license. HENNING informed P.O. PRIEWE that he did not know the password to the camera system.
- P.O. PRIEWE was informed by the console operator that the L.I.R.A. site still could not be accessed. The city of Milwaukee License site was checked and it did not appear that SOSMAN had a Class D. Bartender's license.
