The sign prohibiting turns on red was installed because North Renee Street is one-way northbound and West State Street was one-way westbound, which conflicted with southbound traffic on North 17th Street. Due to the two-way conversion of West State Street from North 11th Street to North 35th Street, we recommend the removal of the sign prohibiting turns on red for northbound traffic since it is now prohibited by Statute.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety Committee meeting so that you may support it to final passage.
