Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1) On Saturday, 12/02/00 at 12:25AM Officers were dispatched to a noise complaint at Harpo's tavern located at 1339 E. Brady St. Upon their arrival Officers parked over 75 feet from the tavern, and could hear music coming from that location. Upon talking to the manager (Michael W. Ross) he stated that he didn't think the music was too loud. The licensee was not on the scene.

- 2) On Saturday, 03/03/01 at 12:26AM Officers were dispatched to a noise nuisance violation at Harpo's tavern located at 1339 E. Brady St. At about 1:00AM a band started playing, and the Officers could hear the music from about 75 feet away from the tavern. The Class D Bartender (Maren E. Grossman) stated that the Police had been to the bar earlier and warned her to keep the music down. She thought that she had turned the music down enough. The licensee was not on the scene.

3. On 04/01/07 at 1:01 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1337 E Brady Street for a Property Damage complaint. Officers spoke to the licensee, Michael Ross, who stated a patron inside the bar was trying to start a fight with other individuals when he was asked to leave by the bar employees. As the patron exited the tavern he punched a window on the building breaking it. A report was filed.

4. On 10/13/07, Milwaukee police received complaints of noise nuisances coming from the corner of Warren and Brady during bar closing time. Officers were in the area to monitor taverns at bar closing for several days and found no violations as patrons left area taverns. Police will continue to monitor the area.

Officers interviewed the victim Octavian Willson who stated he was working at the tavern when two patrons became disorderly. Once outside, words were exchanged and one of the patrons punched Willson several times about the face. Willson called for police and and both suspects were issued citations.

Upon arrival, Officers interviewed the caller who stated that the bartender threw away a piece of his property and refused to give him back his debit card. When he asked the bartender to look through the garbage for his property, the bartender threw the garbage can at the caller striking him in the chest and neck causing pain. Officers then tried to interview the bartender but he was not cooperating and refused to provide his information or let officers look at surveillance video which might have captured the incident. The bartender lied to officers and told them that it was not him who threw the garbage can. The bartender only provided his identification when officers told him that he would be arrested if he did not cooperate with the investigation. The bartender was issued citations. A witness later told police that the bartender threw the garbage bag over the bar but it never hit the caller.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by P.O. Kristina BRIDGER, assigned to District 1, Late Shift.

On Monday, April 04, 2022 at approximately 12:33 am, Squad 1332 (myself in full-duty uniform equipped with an activated Axon Body-Worn Camera and in a marked squad car and Squad 1322 (P.O. Jacob ROECKER) were dispatched to Club Brady at 1339 E. Brady Street (located in the City and County of Milwaukee) for a Battery call.

Upon arrival, I spoke with the caller, identified as Jessiah S. BAILLIES (m/w, 06-02-73), who stated that the bartender of Club Brady was refusing to give his property back and had assaulted him. BAILLIES stated that the bartender had thrown away something BAILLIES had on the bar, which was a small object used for magic tricks. BAILLIES had requested to look through the garbage bag to find his property. BAILLIES stated that the bartender then took the garbage bag and threw it at BAILLIES, which hit him in the chest and neck area, which caused him pain. BAILLIES stated that is when he called for police to respond and then the bartender took the garbage bag without allowing BAILLIES to look for his property. BAILLIES stated that he also gave his debit card to the bartender in order to pay for a beer that he had ordered and consumed and the bartender never gave it back to him.

P.O. ROECKER was already on scene upon my arrival and was inside speaking with the bartender. When I entered the bar and spoke with P.O. ROECKER, he informed me that the bartender was not cooperating and was refusing to provide his information. I then spoke with the bartender and requested his information, to which the bartender stated he was not going to give us his information because he didn't do anything. I asked the bartender if he had access to the video cameras inside the bar so that we could investigate the claim made against regarding the battery. The bartender stated that he did have access to the cameras, but he wasn't going to let us look at them. I again informed the bartender that we can clear up the allegations by reviewing the video, to which the bartender responded that we could wait until 2:00 am then to review the video. This conversation was taking place at approximately 1:00 am and I told the bartender that we could not wait that long. The bartender had stated that he had given the garbage to BAILLIES, but he did not throw it at him and simply placed it over the bar, so he did nothing wrong and he did not have to provide any information to us. After asking about the cameras, the bartender then changed his story and stated that it wasn't even him that dealt with BAILLIES, that it had been another bartender that looked exactly like him. P.O. ROECKER and I then informed the bartender that if he wasn't going to provide his information and cooperate, we would arrest him for the accused battery charge and obstructing a police officer. Only then did he provide his Wisconsin driver's license,

which identified him as Shawn C. CASPER (m/w, 11-13-86).

Due to CASPER's refusal to cooperate with us during our investigation, P.O. ROECKER issued CASPER a citation for obstruction, Citation #J981NJ1GGC. CASPER was also issued a citation for the battery accusation, Citation #J981NJ1GGD. CASPER also stated that BAILLIES had thrown a napkin with a rock or piece of ice inside of it, which hit him and caused him pain. BAILLIES was also issued a citation for battery, Citation #J981NJ1GGF.

While P.O. ROECKER was writing the citations, a witness did come forward to me and identified himself as Shawn C. DAVIS (m/w, 01-18-85). DAVIS said that he was playing pool while this incident occurred. DAVIS stated that CASPER did throw the garbage bag, but he threw it over the bar and onto the ground in front of BAILLIES. DAVIS said that the bag never hit CASPER in the chest, but stated that BAILLIES began yelling that CASPER had assaulted him.

Squad 1310 (Sergeant Nicholas RICE) responded to the call on BAILLIES' request. Sgt. RICE asked CASPER again if we can review the video. CASPER stated that the incident occurred in a blind spot of the cameras, so it would not be on video. Sgt. RICE asked if we could review the footage anyway just to make sure, and CASPER stated multiple times that it wouldn't be on video. CASPER finally stated that he would let us review the video if we "tore up the ticket".

BAILLIES was insistent that his debit card was still in the bar. I checked the whole area behind the bar and the surrounding area by the seats and I did not locate his debit card. CASPER stated that they do not keep credit or debit cards, that they give the cards back right after they run them. CASPER said that he did not have BAILLIES' debit card.

I informed CASPER that I would be filing this license premise report.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 06/06/2022 at 10:40 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


