


One (1) New Routed Aluminum Face for an Existing Illuminated Monument Sign

Single Sided

Size: 4' x 8'

(A) Sign Face:

Routed 1/8" aluminum face (no exposed fasteners), backed with white acrylic, 3M translucent film on 1st surface of back up acrylic. (white outline required on copy)


Installation Method:

Cut out existing aluminum face leaving 2" +/- border to stud mount new routed aluminum face.

Colors:

- (1)  Paint to match 3M Light Beige film 3630-149
- (2)  3M translucent film Dark Brown 3630-59
