There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

8. On 10/29/24 at 12:56a.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check. The officer spoke to the owner who stated it was their grand opening and they plan to run the business more like a restaurant. Further stated they will have 8-9 security guards, will be making people leave ½ hour before bar close and security will be escorting patrons to their vehicles.
9. On 12/29/24 at 12:00a.m, Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check. The Agent was on scene and provided with security, noise and flow of traffic suggestions. While the officer was on scene a noise complaint came in, however, the officer observed it was due to traffic in the area, not the business.
10. On 01/20/25 at 5:55p.m., Milwaukee Police took a Walk-in Battery, that occurred between 01/18/25 11:00p.m., and 01/19/25 12:15a.m. The victim stated they were strangled inside the business, then struck on the head with a glass bottle outside, causing them to receive stitches. The victim stated they requested video from the business, however, were told they did not have video surveillance.
11. On 02/20/25 at 11:30p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting. On arrival officers interviewed a security officer, who had a holster, however was unarmed. The security guard stated they heard an argument in front of the business, then two shots fired. The security denied knowing who fired the shot, however, one casing was recovered under their vehicle. Two victims stated they were kicked out of the business, and a physical fight took place outside, when the owner pointed a gun at their group, and other staff retrieved firearms from inside and shot at them. A co-owner arrived on scene, however, stated they had to leave due to child care issues. The Agent arrived on scene and stated they recently had video surveillance installed, however, did not know the password. The Agent provided officers with a phone number for the installer, however, it went to voicemail. The officers noted management and staff were uncooperative with officers initially. No victim was located.
12. On 03/04/25 at 5:35p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted follow up at the business regarding an illegal dumping complaint. Officers attempted to interview a manager, however, they were uncooperative and refused to allow officers to view video surveillance. The manager appeared hostile toward officers.
13. On 03/09/25 at 1:39a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery. Officers interviewed the intoxicated caller who stated an employee hit them in the back of the head, however, changed their story a few times. An employee stated the subject was not assaulted and only escorted out. The employee stated officers could review video surveillance but asked the officer to come back later as they were busy. The officer was unable to return to the location.
14. On 03/13/25 at 11:09p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Weapon. On arrival officers interviewed the parties involved who stated it was a verbal argument in the parking lot and nothing took place inside the business. Both parties left the scene with no further incident.
15. On 04/25/25 at 8:24p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check regarding an Aldermanic Complaint about cones in the street in front of the location. Officers advised security to move the cones off the street, but remained in the area and observed an employee arrive and put the cones back. The officers returned and advised the employee, who became argumentative about removing the cones, however, eventually moved the cones to the curb.

16. On 05/09/25 at 6:00p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Traffic Hazard. Officers found 10-15 cones in the street in front of the business. Officers spoke to two employees and advised them to move the cones, however, they refused to move them. The officer began to move them and one of the subjects stated they would put them back as soon as police left. The officer issued a citation for the violation, however, as of the date of this report, I was unable to locate it.

KEITH stated that it was their grand opening tonight and after this week he plans to run the location as more of a restaurant. KEITH stated he doesn't want to interrupt with the business across the street (Gold Digger's) so he wants to be closed up before they get busy. KEITH stated they operate with eight or nine security guards both inside and out. KEITH stated he's received a citation in the past for people being in the bar after close so he starts kicking people out at least a half hour before bar close to make sure everyone is out on time. KEITH stated at the end of the night his security escorts people to their vehicles and makes sure they leave so there isn't any loitering around after close. KEITH stated he's owner of another location in District 4 so he understands what's expected of him and he wouldn't mind police presence to keep certain individuals away. I gave KEITH my contact card and advised him to contact me if he had any issues or big events planned.

This report was written by P.O. Stephon ROBY assigned to District Seven, Late Power Shift.

On Sunday, December 29th, 2024, at approximately 12am, Squad 7468, P.O. Taylor MOTIFF and I conducted a tavern check at Options Restaurant & Lounge which is located at 4747 N. Hopkins St.

Upon arrival, we spoke to the registered agent, Sheila T. NGUYEN A/F 11-02-84, who stated that they have 8-armed security officers that monitors the entrance/ exits, and the exterior of the location which includes the parking lot. I informed NGUYEN that she needs to make sure the music is played inside of the tavern is at a reasonable level, so it does not cause a nuisance to the neighbors. I also informed NGUYEN that she needs to make sure her security officers are keeping the flow of traffic moving and not allowing vehicles to stop in traffic with their hazard lights on.

While on scene, I received a noise nuisance call for at 4750 N. Hopkins St. which is directly across the street from Options Restaurant & Lounge. The call indicated that the unknown vehicles are playing loud music causing a disturbance. While on scene, I observed vehicles drive by that played loud music, but I did not observe any of those vehicles stop to enter either of the bars. I attempted to call the caller back, but the caller did not accept phone calls. The call was deemed baseless.

This report is written by Police Officer (P.O.) Elizabeth McDaris, assigned to District Three, Early Shift, Front Desk.

On Monday, January 20, 2025, at approximately 5:55pm, while working at the front desk of District Three police station, a Black female (who verbally identified herself as Domonique S. Gillespie, B/F, 09-01-85) (who resides at 2338 N. 40 St. in Milwaukee, WI / #920-460-1002) walked into the police station and reported a Strangulation and Suffocation AND a Substantial Battery (domestic violence modifier) incident that occurred between approximately 11:00pm on January 18, 2025 to 12:15am on January 19, 2025, at Options Nightclub (4747 N. Hopkins St., which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee).

Per Domonique, her ex-boyfriend strangled her while inside of this location and then struck her on the head with a glass tequila bottle outside of this location during a physical altercation. Domonique received several stitches on her hand to treat the injuries she sustained during this incident.

Domonique stated that, although several of the suspect's friends were present for this incident, she did not have their contact information.

As Domonique walked into the District Three police station, where I was assigned to work for that shift, I did not respond to Options Nightclub to speak with any of the licensed premise subjects.

A Google search only revealed two possible telephone numbers for Options Nightclub (#414-345-8406 or #414-873-1220), both of which were out of service.

Domonique stated that she had reached out to Options Nightclub and was informed that the video cameras at this location did not work.

As Options Nightclub is located in a different district (District Five) than the district in which I am assigned (District Three), it is unknown whether this location is a designated nuisance premise.

Upon arrival we spoke with multiple security guards and advised them that there was a complaint about the cones in the street impeding traffic. We advised them that the cones needed to be moved off of the street. Neither owner was present at the time and security removed the cones. We changed locations to the area of N Hopkins St and W Hampton Ave to observe the location. While observing the location we searched the ordinance's to locate which one was being violated and found 115-32 Obstruction on Public Ways. According to the ordinance a letter needs to be sent to the location advising them they have 5 days from receiving the letter to clear the obstruction. While we were observing the location, Justin K FORNEY (B/M 03-18-1980) arrived at the location, parked in front, and moved the cones back on the road way. We went back and spoke to FORNEY who was argumentative about removing the cones. FORNEY stated he had the cones there for safety reasons because he didn't want patrons to be able to park there in case they were kicked out and could access firearms in their vehicle quickly. FORNEY also stated there was a neighbor that calls all the time about noise complaints and he didn't want patrons parking in front of the location and playing loud music because he would get blamed for it.
