WHEREAS, *Anthony "Tony" Courtney is the founder of several nonprofit organizations include For My Brothers, Inc., an organization that provided manhood training for Black boys ages 13-15 years old, and today Tony continues to serve as a mentor to Black men ages 30-60 years old; and*

WHEREAS, *Tony Courtney is also the Founder of Old School We Ain't Through Yet-Black Men's Network that encourages Black men to participate in, and be aware of, community efforts, events and interests led by other Black-organized groups; and*

WHEREAS, *Tony Courtney's other endeavors include founding 100 Black Men of Milwaukee, United Black Community Center, and under his business My Brothers Gold Cards, he has authored several booklets and posters; and*

WHEREAS, *Tony Courtney has been recognized by numerous organizations for his community involvement and uplifting of Black men, all in the name of supporting others, helping the community, and being a man of God; now, therefore, be it*
