There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

On 02/11/09 at 6:21 pm, Milwaukee police were conducting Sales of Alcohol to Minors and had two Milwaukee police aides, who are under the age of 21, enter 7023 W Adler in attempts to purchase alcohol. The bartender Rober Sielen did view both police aides ID and still served them bottles of Miller Lite beer. Officers cited the licensee Stephen Silber for Sale To Underage Person.

- 2. On 02/12/10 at 1:43 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 7023 W Adler for an Armed Robbery complaint. Officers spoke to the bartender Wendy Hahn who stated an unknown subject entered the tavern, stated something and then racked a bullet into the chamber of a gun while walking behind the bar. Hahn stated the suspect demanded she open the cash register and when she did, he removed the money and fled the tavern. No injuries were reported. The licensee, Stephen Silber was not on scene at the time of the incident however arrived during the police investigation.
- 3. On 11/13/10 at 1:27 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 7023 W Adler Street for an Armed Robbery complaint. Investigation revealed that 2 unknown males entered the tavern with masks covering their lower faces and were armed with semi-automatic guns. One suspect began physically fighting with a patron while the other suspect attempted to gain entry into the cash register. The suspect was unable to open the register but obtained money that was left on the bar and from an envelope that was near the register. Both suspects then fled the bar. Officers obtained several witnesses statements and the incident was caught on video surveillance. A report was filed.

4. On 11/02/11 at 2:07 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 71st and Adler Streets for Welfare Check as the caller referenced Mortimer's Pub. Officers were also told that two were fighting at that location and that one actor left the scene. Upon arrival, officers spot the bartender Dana Wallace who informed police that two patrons were involved in a fight that they had left prior to police arrival. Wallace stated that one of the patrons attempted leave the bar with a bottle of beer when the other patron tried to stop him in the entryway tavern when a fight started between the two. Wallace stated she did observed blood on the patron's forehead but that she was unsure as to where the subject went after leaving bar. Police also spoke with the caller who stated she observed two men fighting outside bar and was concerned for the welfare of the actors, in particular the one who was on the ground getting punched.	oke with ght, but do to ay to the of one of the ethe

 On 03/16/2020 officers conducted a license premise check at Mortimer's Pub, 7023 W. Adler St. The officer spoke with the bartender and advised him of the current rules regarding mandatory closures. The staff stated they understood the orders.

6. On 11/03/21 at 11:08pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 7023 W. Adler Street. The only violation was their Class B Tavern License was not posted (but was corrected the next day when officers conducted follow-up). The employee was very cooperative and the encounter was a positive community contact.

7. On 01/21/23 at 1:18am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 7023 W. Adler Street for a subject with gun compliant. Investigation revealed that the bartender, who was very cooperative, did not observe anyone with a firearm and all customers were regulars.




City Concentration Map 7023 W ADLER ST Milwaukee

Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
