Description of work

Reinstall new glass and concrete material to recreate the American Legion Star emblem on the eastern slope of Kilbourn Reservoir Park. The star will be a permanent installation composed of recycled, tumbled glass and concrete poured into the original iron template that will be imbedded in the hillside. The actual pieces of glass will be 3/8" to 1/2" in size and the surface will be coated with a sealer that will make it easier to clean.



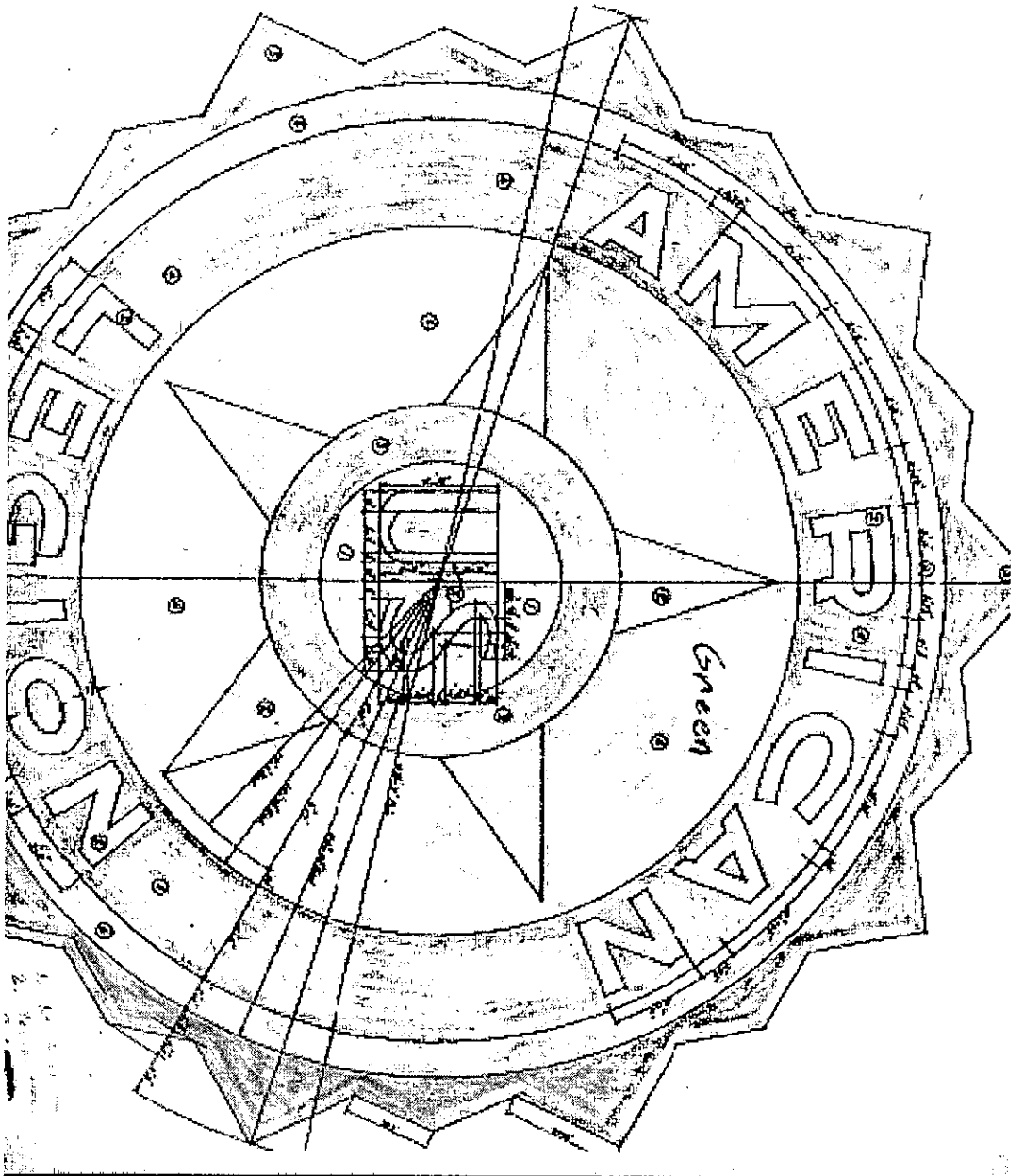
All work will be done according to the attached drawings. Ring will be installed on east/southeast side of hill.
