Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity, public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 09/30/07 at 8:42 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2533 W Auer Avenue for a Reckless Use Of A Weapon complaint. Investigation revealed a woman who was at Big Larry's Place with her boyfriend, got into an argument which turned physical. The victim stated her boyfriend left the tavern briefly only to return and start physically fighting her again. The victim then stated her boyfriend pulled out a gun and pointed it in her face stating, "Bitch I'll kill you!" The victim's boyfriend then fled and the victim stated she walked up to the bar owner, Larry, and was told by Larry to leave the tavern. Officers made a call to the tavern and spoke to a male who identified himself as "Larry" but was shortly hung up on by "Larry". Officers went to 2378 N 12th (Big Larry's) in attempts to locate the victim's boyfriend and observed the tavern lights on inside and outside of the tavern. When officers attempted to enter the tavern they found the door locked. As officers looked inside the windows, they observed multiple drinks and glasses on the bar that still contained various liquids. Officers attempted to contact the licensee, Bradford Allen, via phone, but were met with negative results.

2. On 12/13/2008 Milwaukee Police conducted a license check of the premise at 2378 North 12th Street (Big Larry's). All licenses were found to be in order and no violations were observed.

3. On 04/10/09 at 10:28 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1303 W Meinecke for a Battery complaint. Investigation revealed an intoxicated patron became disorderly and slap the bartender, identified as Bradford Allen, in the face. Allen then attempted to remove this patron and while doing so, knocked the patron to the floor where he hit his face. Both subjects were cited for Assault & Battery.

4. On 11/27/11 at 1:17 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2378 N 12th Street for an Armed Robbery complaint. Investigation revealed four patrons exited the bar to smoke cigarettes when four subjects approached them from different directions, two of which exited "Cherries Place", a tavern located at 2401 N 12th Street. Two suspects were armed with guns and demanded money and property. The other two suspects were possibly armed and took up support positions. Three of the victims fled the area when they the suspects armed with guns. As the three victims fled, the suspects fired several shots at them.. The fourth victim had a gun put to his head and was told to give up his property and money. The suspects obtained the victim's wallet and then all suspects fled the scene. It was later determined that one of the fleeing victim's was shot to his lower right leg and was treated at an area hospital. Police spoke with Bradford Allen who stated at the time of the shooting, he was in the bathroom starting to clean up for the night and didn't hear the shots. Allen stated that one of the patrons did open the door and yelled for him that someone just got shot. Allen stated the shooting victim was inside the tavern before he was shot, but that there were no problems or arguments in the bar that night. There was no video surveillance system in the bar.

5. On 04/14/12 at 11:28 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2363 N 12th Street for a Spotter System call of shots fired. Investigation revealed two males were walking past Big Larry's located at 2378 N 12th Street when they saw a male standing outside the bar and asked him for a cigarette. This subject said no and an argument starting between the parties. The male that was standing outside the bar then hollered for "Jerry" who was inside the bar and told him to get his gun. "Jerry" exited the bar holding a black hand gun and the two subjects then fled the area, and upon doing so, heard one gun shot coming from the area of the tavern. Follow up was conducted by a detective and spoke with Bradford Allen, the agent, who stated he did call police regarding the incident, but that he did not hear shots and did not know anyone by the name "Jerry" that fit the description provide to police of the shooter. Allen stated he does not have any surveillance cameras on location.

7. On 12/23/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a shots fired complaint at the intersection of North 12th Street and West Meinecke Avenue. Officers discovered a bullet hole in the window of a vehicle as well as a bullet hole in a window of Big Larry's Lounge (2378 North 12th Street). While video recovered from another business includes this incident, it is unclear who or what was the intended target of the shooter. Milwaukee police incident report #143570121 filed.

8. On 05/13/17, Milwaukee police responded to a shooting at St Joseph's Hospital. Police spoke with the shooting victim who stated he was leaving a bar around closing and that there was a group of people arguing outside the bar. The victim heard gunshots and he ran to his car. As he was driving away, he felt his leg begin to hurt and noticed he was shot. The victim couldn't provide any description stating he didn't observe who was shooting.

- 9. On 10/27/2018 officers were dispatched to Big Larry's, 2378 N. 12th St, for a Trouble with Subject. The applicant was on scene and stated a subject had been banned from the tavern and had returned four times. The subject was located outside and issued a citation for Trespassing.
- 10. On 11/08/2018 officers were dispatched to Big Larry's, 2378 N. 12th St, for an Entry complaint. The officer found the rear door open with pry marks on it. The suspects attempted to pry the interior door open but did not gain entry. Nothing was obtained from the premise.

- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.




