Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie A. Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officer Michael Anderson. The claim is in the amount of \$816.75 including \$2.75 in disbursements for 7.40 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by the filing of a citizen's complaint against the officers with the Fire and Police Commission. The complaint was dismissed by the Commission.
