File # 030466 is a resolution amending Common Council File 020931 relative to application, acceptance and funding of the Wisconsin Wins Grant.

Background

- 1. This resolution amends Common Council File 020931 relative to application acceptance and funding of the Wisconsin Wins grant project from the Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services.
- 2. This grant amendment increases funding by \$18,000; the original grant was for \$67,500.

Discussion

- 1. The purpose of this project is to reduce the rate at which tobacco retailers sell tobacco products to underage youth.
- 2. This grant will fund a "Recognition and Reminder" campaign focused toward retailers and clerks who sell tobacco products. The goal is to assist and reward retailers who refrain from selling tobacco products to minors.
- 3. This grant will continue to encompass the period of October 1, 2002 through September 30, 2003.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total of this grant amendment is \$18,000, entirely from the grantor.
- 2. \$16,200 is budgeted for the contract with *Strive Media Youth* to assure that retailers are in compliance with Wisconsin statutes governing the sale of tobacco to minors by providing for additional compliance checks per Wisconsin Wins protocol.
- 3. \$1,800 will be used for the purchase of computer equipment.
