Circumstances of Claim: On August 10, 2022, our tenant Ryan Crowley called to report that a city garbage truck had damages our garage at our rental unit located at 100-02 N. 76<sup>th</sup> Street. He told me what happened, and I asked him to please write a statement and send it to me. He said that he went to work in the morning and when he came from work, he saw the damage on the garage where the garbage cans were in the morning. He said there was no damage when he left for work.

When he left for work the garbage cans were full and when he got home from work the garbage cans were empty and the garbage cans were not put back where they belong.

I asked him to take a picture of the damage and send them to me. There was damage to the exterior of the garage and a large hole to the inside of the garage. The gutter down spout was crushed and damaged. I have included the picture of the siding, gutter and the inner wall of the garage.

I had the garage repaired on October 12, 2022. That was the soonest repair could have been. I have included the invoice for the damage which is \$3,400.00 along with a copy of the check we paid for the damages.

In August 2022, I contacted the city of Milwaukee regarding the damages to the 100-02 N. 76<sup>th</sup> Street and she gave me directions on how to file a claim.

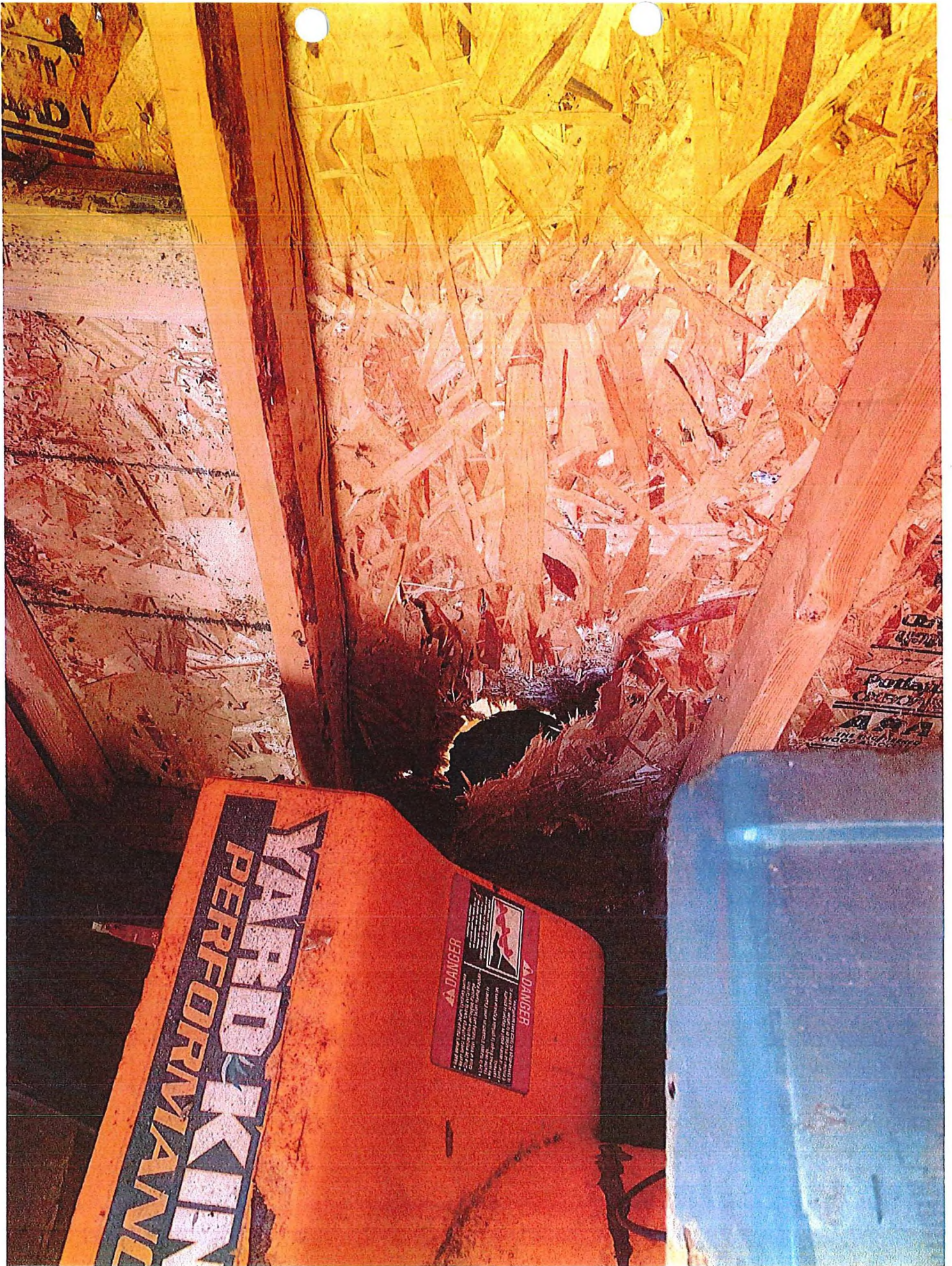
