

Stop the proposed six story development complex at old Hamburger Mary's

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Background (Preamble):

Bay View residents object to the proposed 2130 South Kinnickinnic Avenue six story 144 unit residential and 14,400 square foot ground floor commercial space.

Little concern has been given to the surrounding resident's parking needs, as most properties in the area have no off street parking options, and the proposed project has no parking places for the commercial customers.

This project will claim and destroy a much appreciated city owned green space with mature trees in an area not currently zoned for such a structure. The aesthetics of this towering behemoth which will block out the sun for some neighbors is definitely not desired.
