Subject: South Chase Avenue Bridge
Over the Kinnickinnic River

Dear Council Members:

South Chase Avenue Bridge over the Kinnickinnic River is currently under construction. The improvement consists of removing and replacing the bridge structure.

Common Council Resolution File Number 010599, adopted September 25, 2001 approved the reconstruction of South Chase Avenue Bridge over the Kinnickinnic River with Federal/State Aid.

To accommodate the construction, it became necessary to relocate AT&T cable that was in conflict with construction activities at the bridge. AT&T was requested and, in good faith, relocated their cable, a portion of which lies within the adjacent railroad right-of-way. We agreed to pay for this work within the railroad right-of-way to expedite the project.

AT&T has submitted a bill in the amount of \$12,090.42 requesting reimbursement for the costs they incurred for the relocation of their facilities within the railroad right-of-way.

We have prepared and recommend adoption of the attached resolution authorizing and directing the Commissioner of Public Works to reimburse AT&T, \$12,090.42, for their costs.
