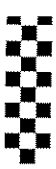

Dear Mr. Chmielewski:

This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$4,505.22, relating to damages sustained to your vehicles on February 29, 2004 when a City of Milwaukee Police vehicle was hit by another vehicle located at South 7<sup>th</sup> Street and West Maple Street.

Our investigation reveals that the Wisconsin Motor Vehicle Accident Report completed as a result of this accident notes that the marked police vehicle had stopped and began to slowly proceed into the intersection when it was hit by another vehicle which was speeding. We have evaluated the liability to be 50 percent on each vehicle. Pursuant to the April 21, 2004 conversation you had with our office, your cars were inspected by our independent appraiser and determined to be total losses. The City of Milwaukee is prepared to offer you \$1,212.50, which is 50 percent of the determined total loss values. As such, the City of Milwaukee proposes to settle this claim for 1,212.50.
