- WHEREAS, Through generations of growth, immigration, hardship, and renewal, St. Matthias expanded its facilities and ministries, faithfully serving Milwaukee families in prayer, education, and community outreach; and
- WHEREAS, For 175 years, St. Matthias has been a light to its community—serving the vulnerable, nurturing faith across all ages, and inspiring parishioners to "Come... live, grow, and be challenged by the message through prayer, formation, and service"; and
- WHEREAS, In 2025, St. Matthias Parish celebrates 175 years of devotion and service, beginning with a Commencement Mass on September 23rd and a Day of Reflection on September 27th, along with other anniversary events throughout the year; now, therefore be,
- **RESOLVED,** That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee herewith congratulates St. Matthias Parish on celebrating 175 years and wishes the parish all the best,
