## Dear Honorable Members:

The 2005 Capital Improvement Program includes the improvements of West Silver Spring Drive from North 26<sup>th</sup> Street to North 43<sup>rd</sup> Street under the Surface Transportation Program. The Federal Program provides cost participation for the improvement of traffic control devices in conjunction with the highway paving.

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) will fund eighty percent of the total cost. The local share, \$27,100.95, will be provided through the Division's existing Capital Improvement Program.

We have, therefore, prepared the attached substitute resolution, which authorizes and directs the Commissioner of Public Works to execute an Agreed Unit Price (AUP) contract with WISDOT that allows city forces to install and/or modify traffic control facilities in conjunction with the improvement of West Silver Spring Drive from North 26<sup>th</sup> Street to North 43<sup>rd</sup> Street in the 1<sup>st</sup> Aldermanic District.
