## Dear Members of the Committee:

Attached hereto is an original resolution for your consideration, which would authorize settlement of the above-noted claim. We make the following recommendation relating to the proposed settlement:

The above-noted matter concerns a collapse of an 8 inch City sewer line on May 14, 2003 in front of 3412 South Ahmedi Avenue. Our investigation revealed that the Milwaukee Water Works repaired a water service leak at the same location on May 9, 2003. Our investigation revealed that the Milwaukee Water Works repair activity on May 9, 2003 was a direct contributory factor to the sewer collapse.

Patrick and Charlene Buckner sustained damages in the amount of \$19,890.37 to their basement due to the sewer collapse and subsequent back-flow. In an effort to compromise and settle their claim in an expeditious manner, they have agreed to accept the total amount of \$10,000.00.
