1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The US Department of Justice Bureau of Justice Assistance Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program is the primary provider of federal criminal justice funding to local governments. The FY2021 Justice Assistance Grant is awarded to the City of Milwaukee through Milwaukee County in the amount of \$392,607. The Milwaukee Police Department will utilize the FY2022 JAG award to purchase Cell Site Simulator technology for use by the Special Investigation Division. This technology allows for law enforcement to use cell phone data to locate high priority suspects and high risk victims such as children and victims of human trafficking.

2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

Cell Site Simulator technology will enhance the operational and technical capabilities of MPD. Absent exigent life-threatening circumstances, Cell Site Simulator technology can only be used pursuant to a court ordered warrant. This technology is also used by the State of Wisconsin Division of Criminal Investigation.
