



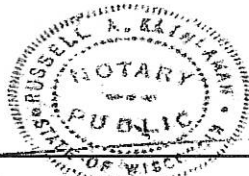

Pursuant to law, the Common Council has scheduled the Neighborhood Improvement District No. 6 (Historic Garden Homes) Annual Meeting for, Monday, May 8th, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at Garden Homes Evangelical Lutheran Church, 2450 West Roosevelt Drive, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, at which time the election of Neighborhood Improvement District board members will be considered.

This notice declares that all individuals who either own or occupy real property within the District are eligible to serve on the Board and vote at the election. The method of electing members to the District Board is cited in Section II.D (9) in the Neighborhood Improvement District Number Six (NID #6) initial year operating plan for Historic Garden Homes, for the area bounded by West Hampton Avenue at North 27th Street proceeding eastward on the south side of West Hampton Avenue to North Teutonia Avenue; proceeding southward on the west side of North Teutonia to West Roosevelt Drive; proceeding eastward on the north side of West Roosevelt Drive to North 27th Street; and proceeding northward on the eastside of North 27th Street to end at West Hampton Avenue. The original of the legislation is on file in the office of the City Clerk located on the 2nd floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, where said proposed legislation may be examined on any weekday between 8:00 a.m. and 4:45 p.m.
