Dear Sir or Madam:

We hereby give Notice of Injury sustained by our client, Santana Stingley, of 4879 North 24th Street, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 893.80. On that date, Ms. Stingley was arrested at her home for a warrant that was incorrectly issued in her name. Ms. Stingley was in her nightgown at the time of arrest and not permitted to put on underwear or pants prior to being placed in the rear of her vehicle. There was no attempt to permit her to obtain pants from her bedroom, and there was further no attempt to await a female officer to come to the property and observe Ms. Stingley changing into pants.

While placing Ms. Stingley under arrest and in the rear of the squad car, MPD officers made inappropriate, discriminatory, and disparaging comments and language regarding her. These comments continued when she awaited booking at MPD District 7. She was then forced to sit in handcuffs without pants or underwear while waiting to be booked.

In light of the transgressions of the City of Milwaukee Police Officers, including Officer Albigame, and the violation of Ms. Stingley's civil rights during and subsequent to her arrest, Ms. Stingley hereby submits a claim for payment of \$75,000.00. A demand is further made for the involved officers to receive sensitivity training. I look forward to your response in this matter.
